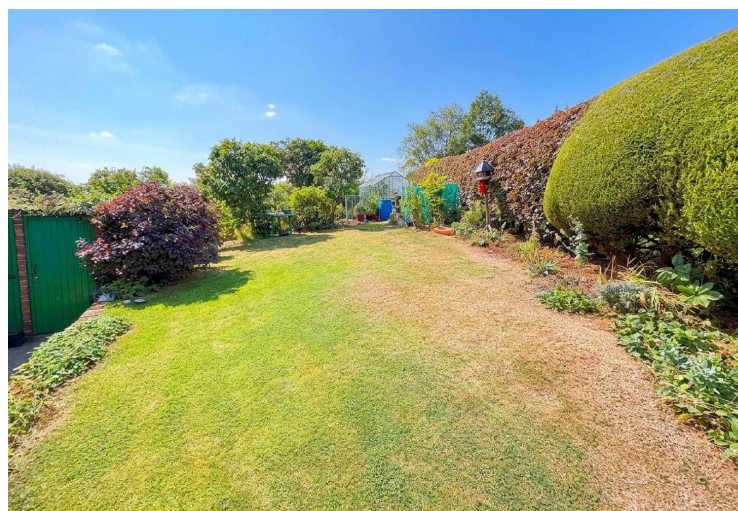

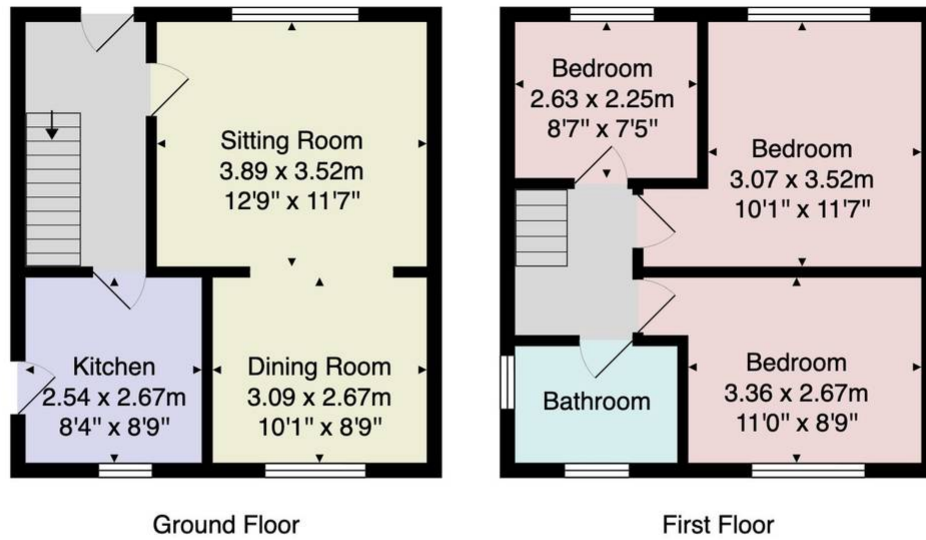


The property has been a much-loved family home for many decades and presents an exciting opportunity for a new owner to create a superb home in an idyllic village setting.
