GENERAL REMARKS

4 Cae Hengoed is an impressive modern detached residence, constructed approximately 16 months ago and further enhanced by the current owners. Extending to approximately 2,260 sq ft, with a detached double garage, the property provides beautifully finished family accommodation with generous proportions, excellent natural light and a strong connection to the landscaped gardens and countryside beyond. It represents a rare opportunity to purchase a high-quality modern home in a desirable village setting.

SITUATION

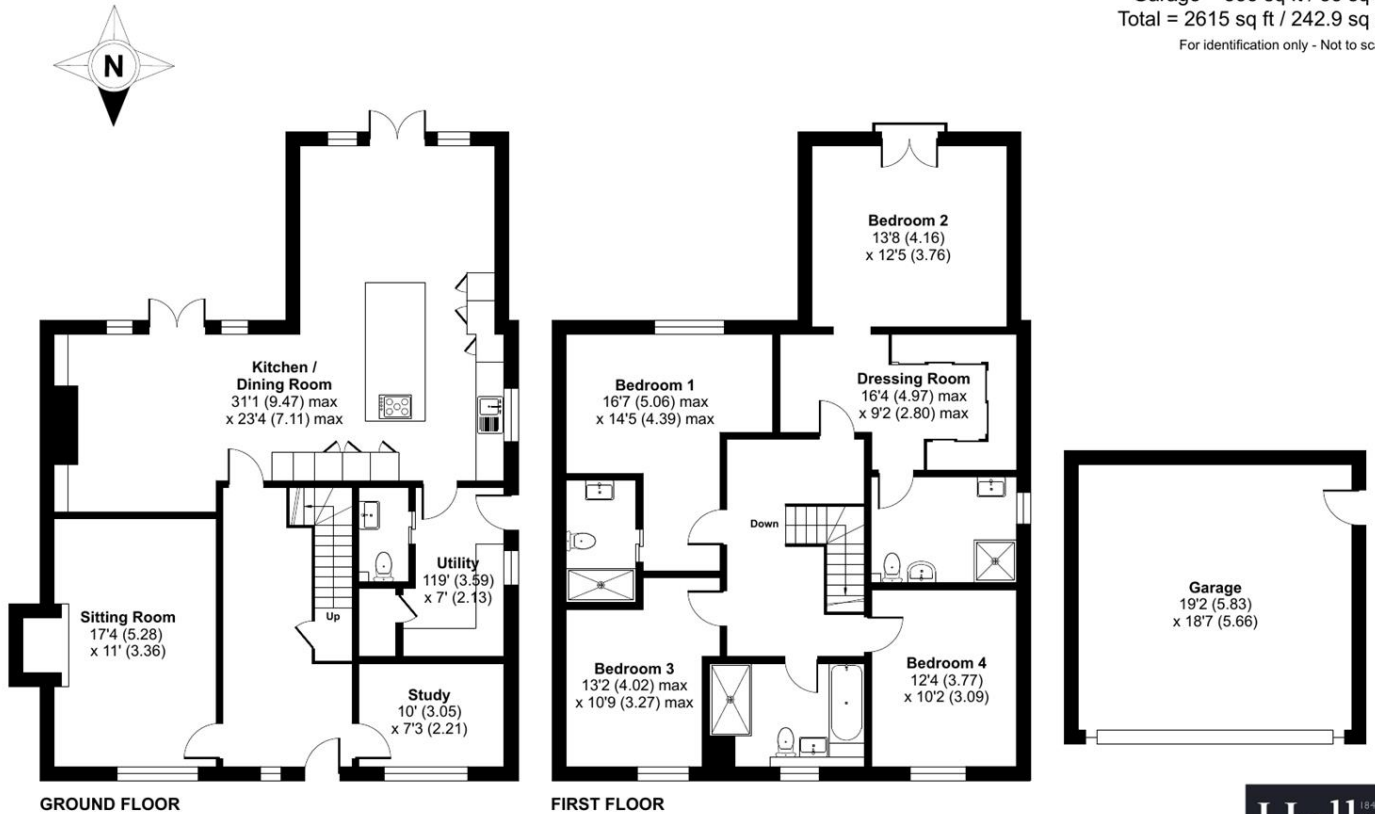
4 Cae Hengoed is positioned within an attractive modern development in the popular village of Hengoed, surrounded by Shropshire countryside and within easy reach of Oswestry, Gobowen and Ellesmere. The setting offers a rare balance of village living, open outlook and day-to-day convenience, with Oswestry providing a wide range of shops, schools, leisure facilities and professional services.

The property is well placed for Oswestry, Gobowen, Ellesmere and the A5, providing links towards Shrewsbury, Chester and the wider region. Gobowen Railway Station is close by, offering services towards Shrewsbury, Chester and Birmingham, with onward connections to London Euston.

Birmingham, Manchester and Liverpool airports are all accessible by road, providing domestic, European and international travel options.

PROPERTY

Internally, the property offers substantial and well-balanced accommodation arranged over two floors. An attractive oak-framed porch leads into a generous reception hall, where tiled flooring, oak internal doors and a staircase rising to the first floor create an immediate sense of quality. The principal ground floor space is the impressive open-plan kitchen and dining room, extending to approximately 31' x 23'4 max.

French doors open directly onto the rear terrace, making it ideal for family life and entertaining. A well-appointed utility room provides further fitted storage, work surface space and external access. There is also a guest cloakroom/WC, a

Separate study/home office and a comfortable sitting room with a feature fireplace and stove. Upstairs, a spacious landing leads to four double bedrooms, including two with en-suites and one with a large dressing room, plus a stylish family bathroom with bath and separate shower. Finished to a high standard throughout, the home combines modern, practical family living with excellent energy efficiency (EPC B).



GARDEN & GROUNDS

The gardens have been thoughtfully landscaped to create an attractive and highly usable outside space. To the rear, a large paved terrace adjoins the kitchen and dining room, providing excellent space for outdoor seating and entertaining. Beyond this is a low-maintenance garden with artificial lawn, raised beds, planted borders and open countryside views beyond. To the front, a generous gravelled driveway provides parking for several vehicles and leads to the detached double garage, which measures approximately 19'2 x 18'7.

A range of local schooling is available in Oswestry, Gobowen and Ellesmere, including primary, secondary and independent education.
