

THORNTON PLACE, CLAPHAM SW4


Built in 1860, Thornton Place is an elegantly restored Grade II listed residence, occupying a commanding position overlooking Clapham Common. This beautifully proportioned lateral third-floor apartment, accessible by lift, combines period grandeur with contemporary comfort.

Flooded with natural light, the south-facing open-plan kitchen and reception room features high ceilings and uninterrupted views over the 220-acre tree-lined common. The apartment offers two well-appointed double bedrooms, both with built-in wardrobes. The principal bedroom has dual-aspect windows and an ensuite shower room, and there is a stylish bathroom to service the second bedroom. Residents enjoy the use of a tranquil private walled garden, alongside the convenience of a dedicated on-site concierge service, making Thornton Place one of the area's most desirable addresses.
