Private off-road parking for two vehicles is available, with direct access to the highway and no shared driveways.

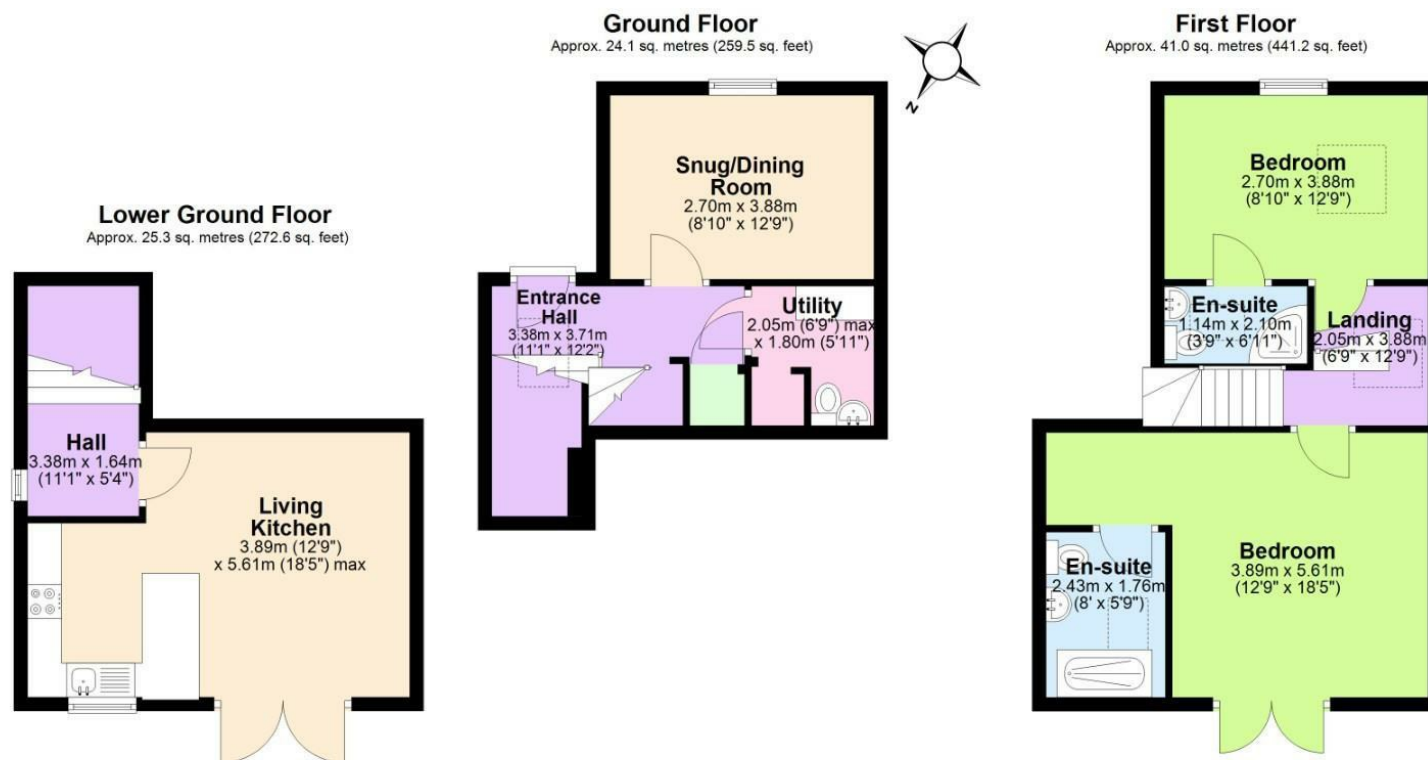
