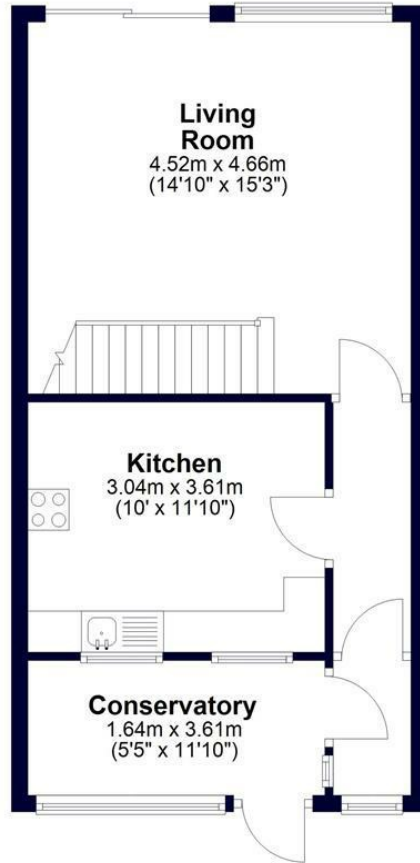

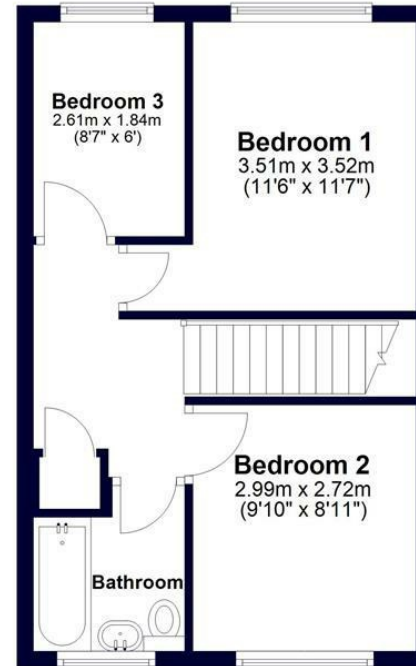
Ground Floor

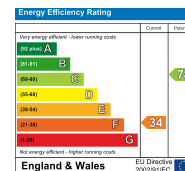
