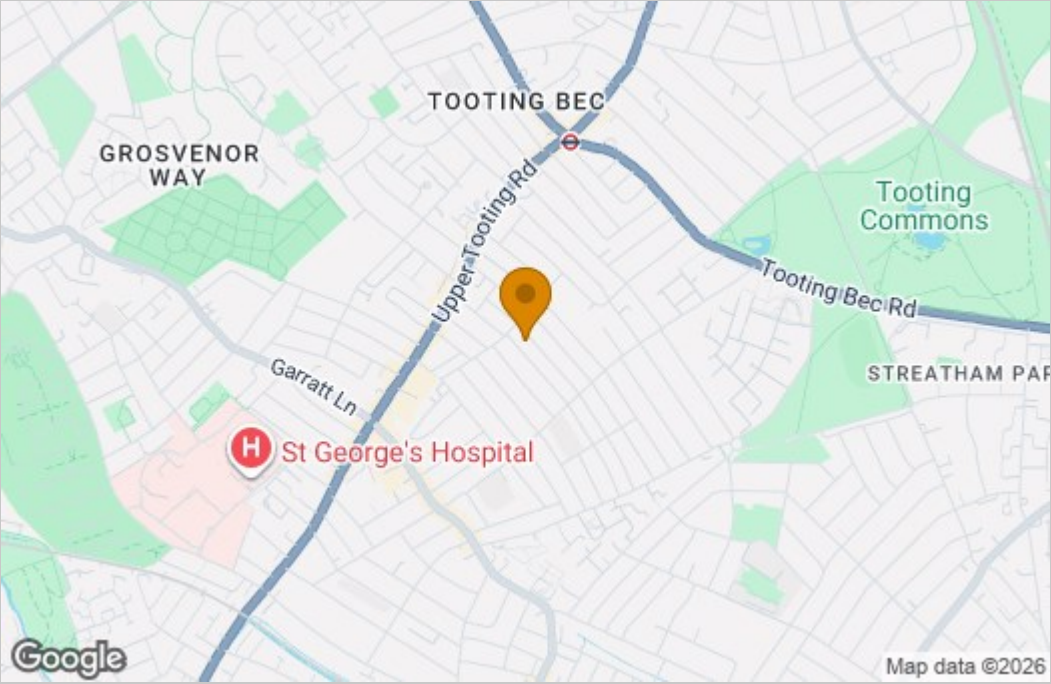
Floor Plan



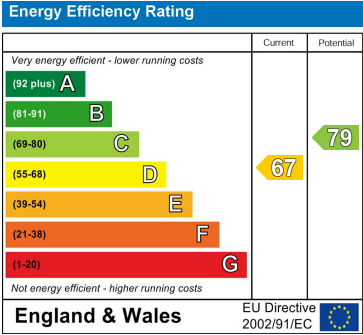
