relaxing, dining or entertaining. French doors provide direct access to the garden, allowing plenty of natural light to flood the space.

Externally, the property benefits from private gardens to both the front and rear, offering a delightful outdoor environment to enjoy throughout the seasons. A driveway provides off-road parking and leads to a single garage, further enhancing the practicality of the home.

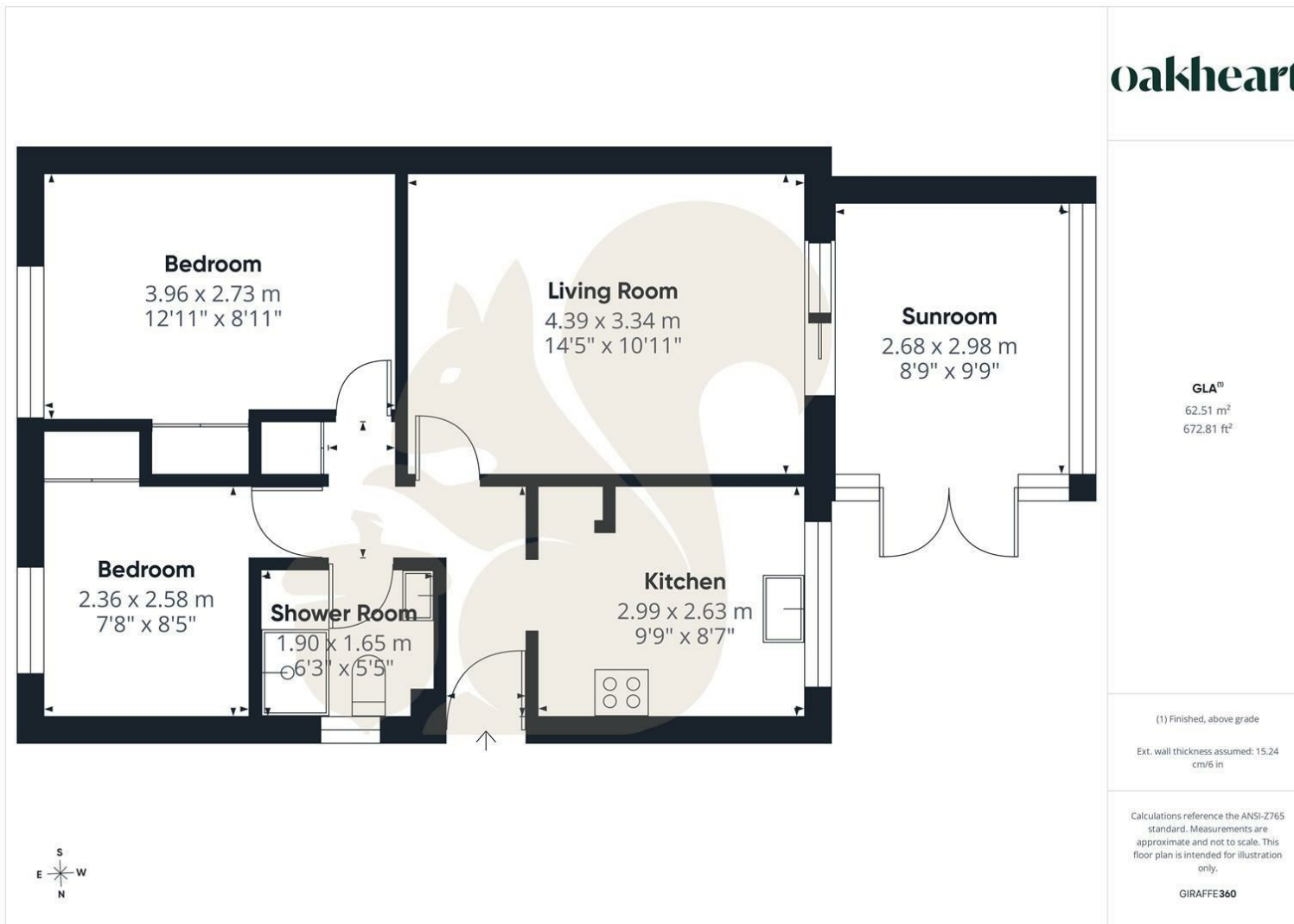
