➡ IF YOU LIVED HERE...

You'll enter to the side, with your 120 square foot, bay-windowed reception room straight ahead. In here, you'll find engineered hardwood floors, high ceilings, and plenty of natural light — a great spot for hosting. Just next door, the kitchen is smartly designed with facing flanks of sleek white cabinetry, complementary worktops, and white letterbox splashbacks.

The two well proportioned bedrooms have the same warm blonde engineered hardwood underfoot, offering a clean and cohesive feel. The bathroom completes the first floor in style, with pristine white tilework and contemporary fittings.

Outside and, as noted, it's less than a half mile on foot to Leytonstone tube. From here the Central line will get you directly to Liverpool Street in just fourteen minutes, for a door to door City commute of well under half an hour. Alternatively, Leyton Midland Road overground is just as close for the Gospel Oak to Barking Riverside line, your direct connection to the River Thames.
