Constructed of stone under a slate roof, the property combines traditional character with modern improvements including a newly fitted kitchen, contemporary vinyl flooring, upgraded electric central heating, double glazing and enhanced insulation with attractive pine cladding finishes.

The accommodation comprises an entrance vestibule, spacious living room, modern kitchen/diner, ground floor bathroom and two first-floor bedrooms.

The bright kitchen/diner has been recently installed and offers excellent storage and workspace, integrated electric oven and ceramic hob, extractor hood and space for dining. The well-proportioned living room enjoys an attractive electric fire with decorative surround, while upstairs both bedrooms benefit from dormer windows allowing excellent natural light.

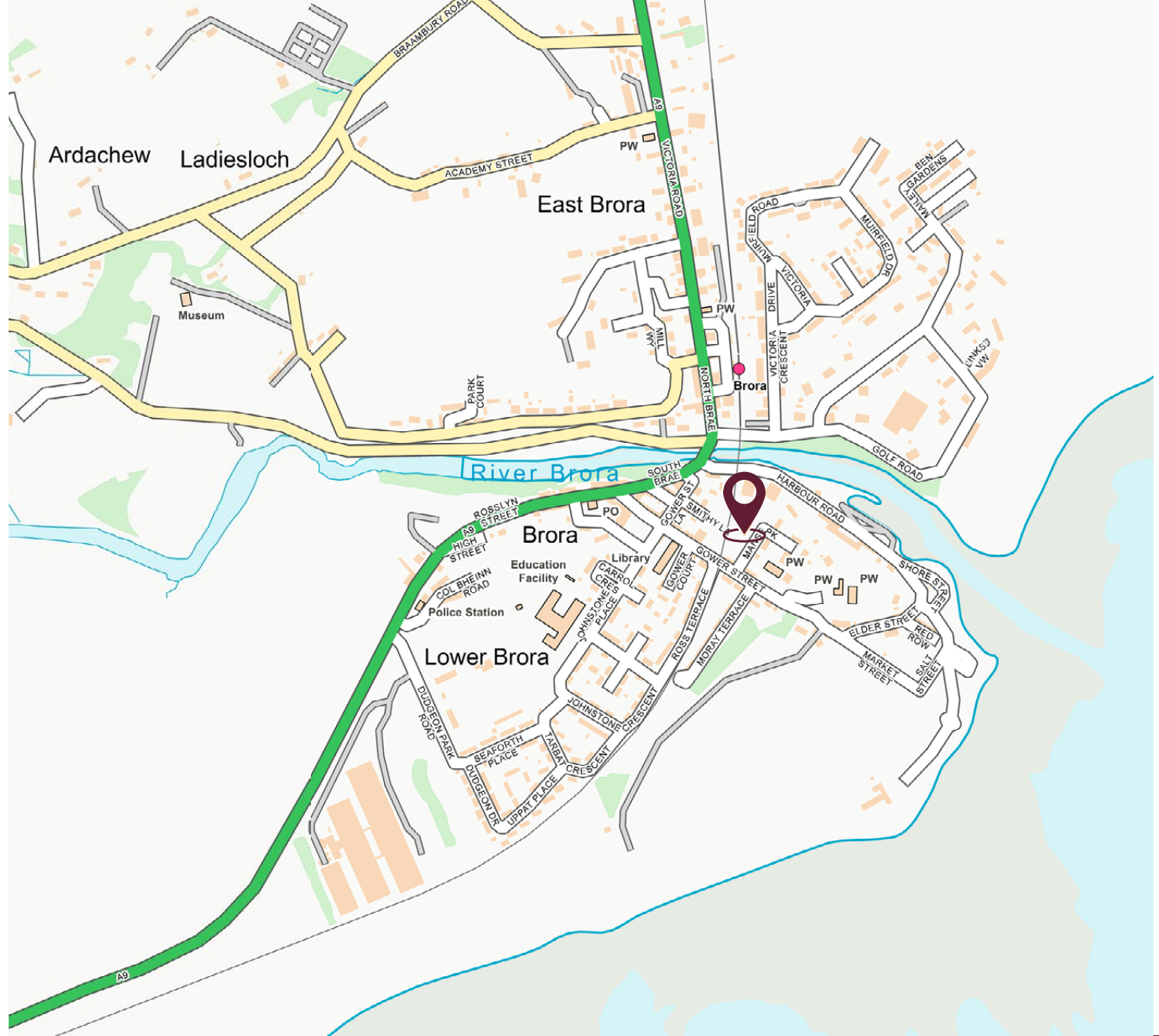
