The Cathedral town of Bury St Edmunds lies in West Suffolk at the heart of East Anglia famous for its Benedictine Abbey. The town has extensive facilities and amenities to cater for all walks of life and has exceptional transport links. The A14 bypasses the town and links the Midlands with the East coast. London via the M11 is 60 miles. The railway station offers services to Cambridge, Norwich and Ipswich with connections for London. A commuter rail link is available at Stowmarket.

This charming end terraced cottage requires significant updating/remedial works but nonetheless occupies a lovely position well placed for the Abbey Gardens, town centre, train station, etc. Further benefits include a part flint walled garden and **NO ONWARD CHAIN**.
