The property offers excellent accommodation over two floors comprising; canopy porch, entrance hall with cloakroom and under stairs cupboard off, full width sitting room with bay window and feature fireplace, dining room with patio doors opening onto the garden, superb kitchen with modern units, integrated appliances and built in double oven, hob and extractor, principle bedroom with en suite shower room, guest bedroom with built in wardrobes, two further bedrooms and a shower room (formerly a bathroom) with contemporary suite.

Externally; there is a small garden to the front with ornamental bushes. To the rear, there is a lovely, private garden with block paved seating area, section of lawn and steps down to a gravelled and paved patio seating area. Large shed/store.

Single garage with up and over door to front, door to side, power and lighting. Driveway parking in front for two cars.

Situation

Paxcroft Mead forms part of the popular village of Hilperton which is situated on the outskirts of Trowbridge and offers its own primary school, public house, church, village hall and is close to open countryside walks and the Kennet and Avon canal. The nearby village of Holt, offers further excellent pubs and the National Trust "The Courts garden" with areas to relax and walk. Transport links include a regular bus service to Trowbridge where there is a main line train station offering easy access to the Georgian city of Bath (approximately 7 miles) and Bristol Temple Meads (approximately 18 miles).

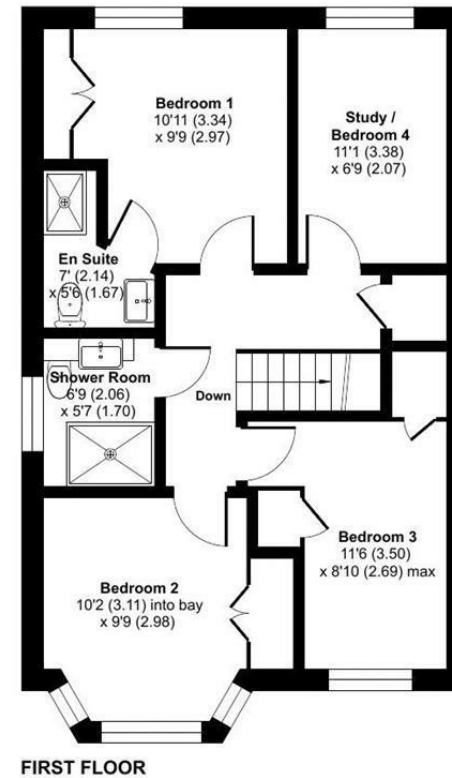
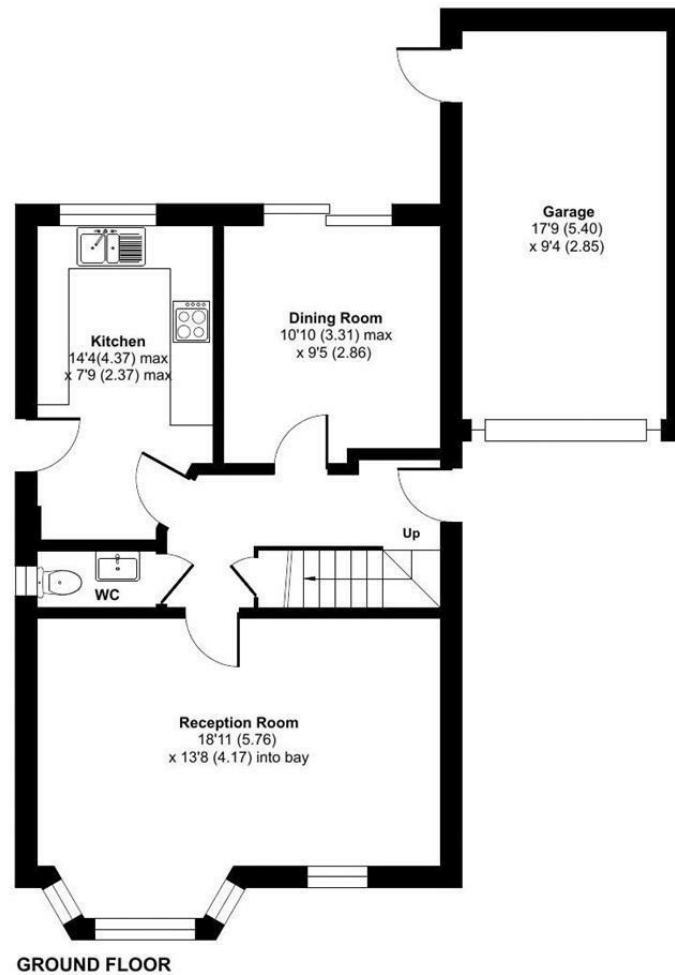
