About The Property

The front door is to the side of the property, covered from the elements by the car port. the entrance hall has stairs to the first floor with an understairs storage cupboard. There is a downstairs cloakroom. The sitting room is to the front with a fireplace and slate hearth. This opens into the double aspect dining room. To the rear is the extended kitchen which has a great range of work surfaces, cupboards and drawers, breakfast bar, sink unit, space and plumbing for washing machine and door to the rear lobby which has a door to the garden and houses the oil fired boiler.

On the first floor are three bedrooms, the main two having built in wardrobes, and a bathroom currently with a disabled access shower. From the landing is a cupboard housing the hot water tank and a hatch to the insulated loft.

Outside, the front garden is laid to lawn with concrete driveway and carport. To the rear of the drive is useful store. A pedestrian gate leads through to the rear garden which has paved areas for sitting, lawn, flower beds and shrubs. Drying area, greenhouse, water tap and oil tank.

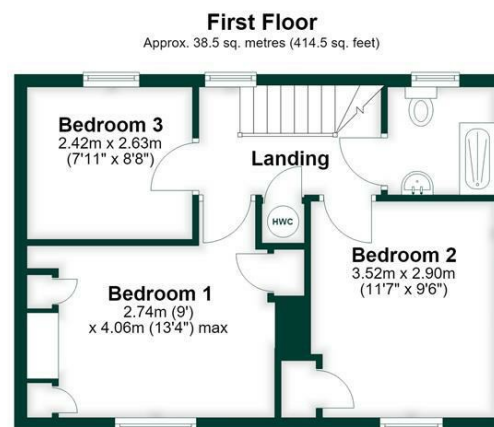
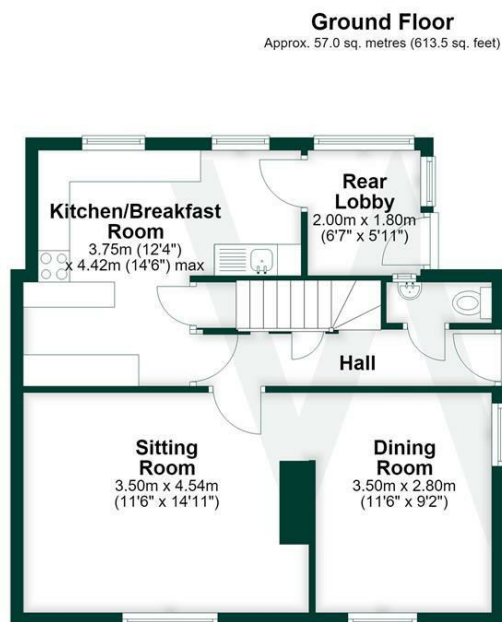
