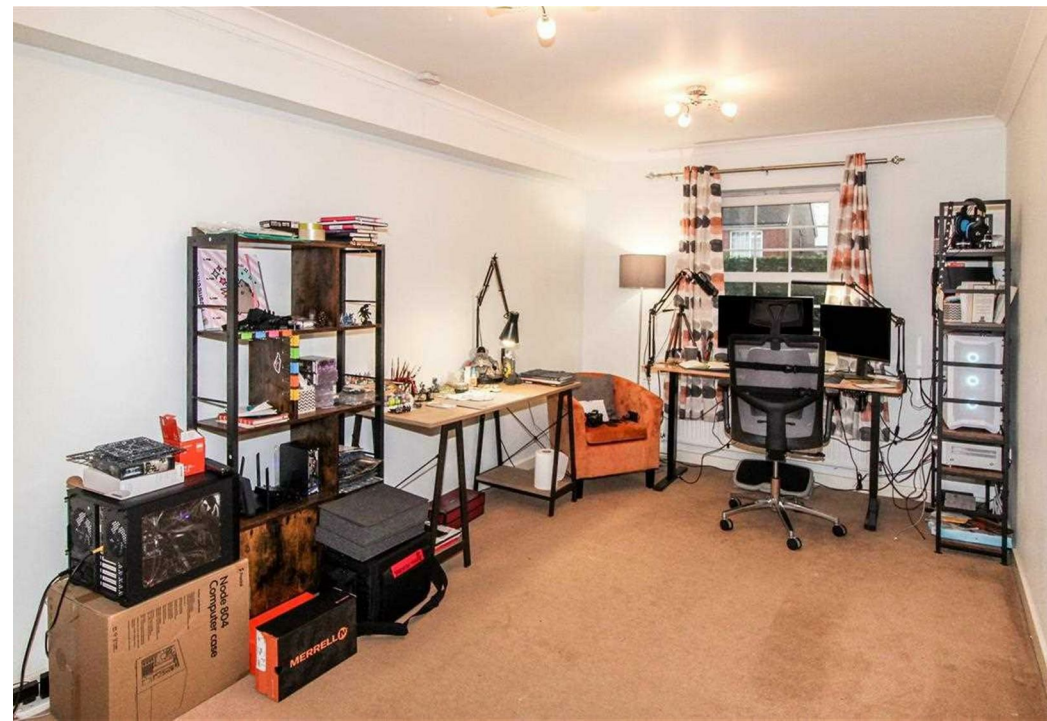


Osterley House, Godwin Way, Horsham, RH13 6SQ

LOCATION

PROPERTY

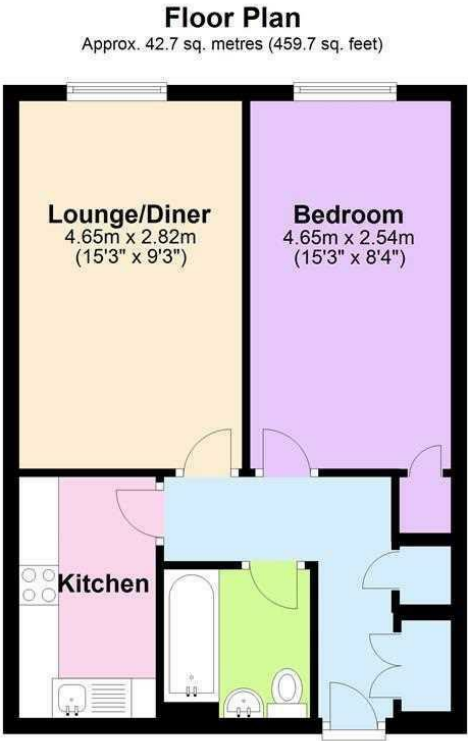
You enter the property into a spacious hallway with good storage cupboards down one side. Directly ahead is the bedroom, which is a good size and has one built-in cupboard. The lounge/diner adjacent to the bedroom is also a good size and neutrally decorated. The well-equipped kitchen has a range of base and wall units, electric oven and hob and integrated fridge with freezer compartment, washer/dryer and dishwasher. A modern white bathroom, with shower over the bath, completes the accommodation. There is gas central heating and a telephone intercom system and an internal viewing is highly recommended.

There is one allocated parking space to the rear of the property and some visitor parking, There are also well kept communal gardens, bike rack and bin store.
