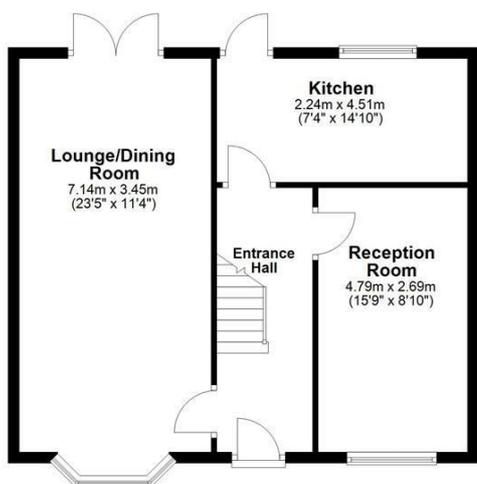

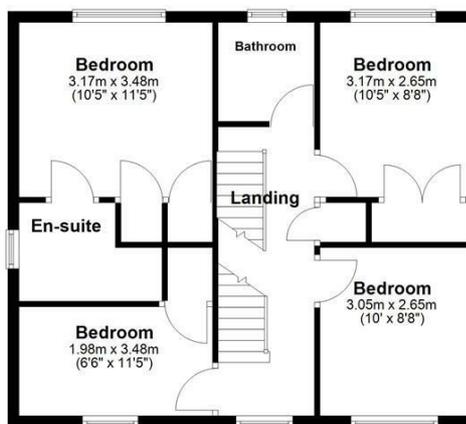

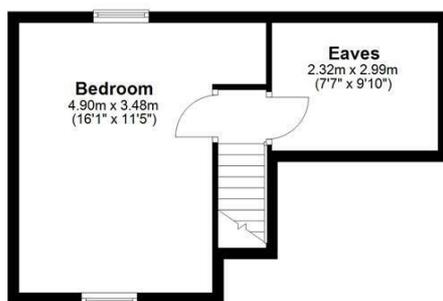
Ground Floor
