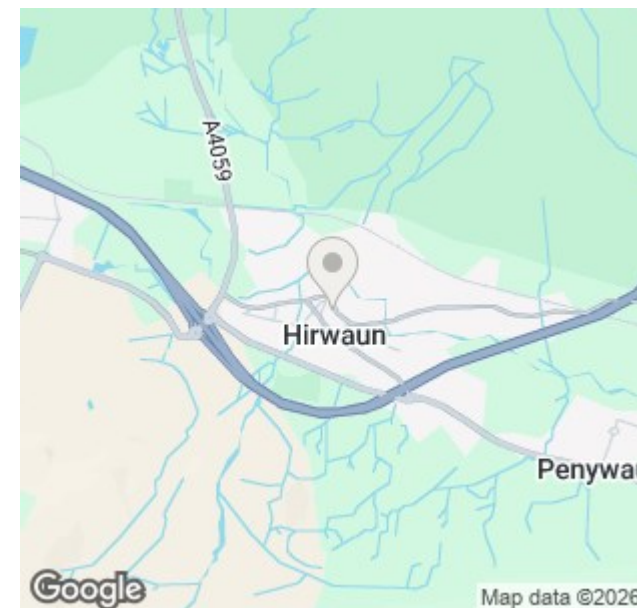

The generous double bedroom provides ample space for furnishings, while the modern shower room is fitted with a stylish three-piece suite including a large walk-in shower.

A staircase leads to an impressive loft room which offers excellent versatility, making it ideal as a home office, dressing room, hobby room or additional storage space (not to be used as a bedroom).

Conveniently positioned within walking distance of local shops, supermarkets, cafés and everyday amenities, the apartment also benefits from excellent transport links via the nearby A465 Heads of the Valleys Road, providing easy access to Aberdare, Merthyr Tydfil, Brecon and the wider South Wales region. Regular bus services operate through the village, with Aberdare railway station approximately 3.5 miles away.
