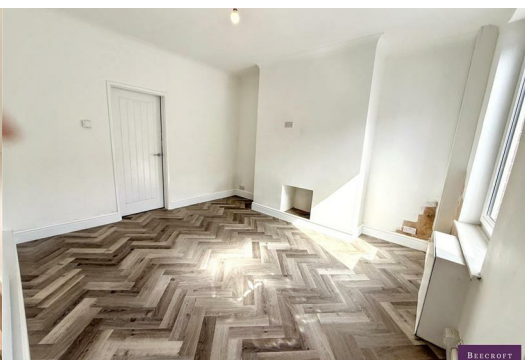

Having a double glazed window and radiator, providing natural light and year-round comfort.

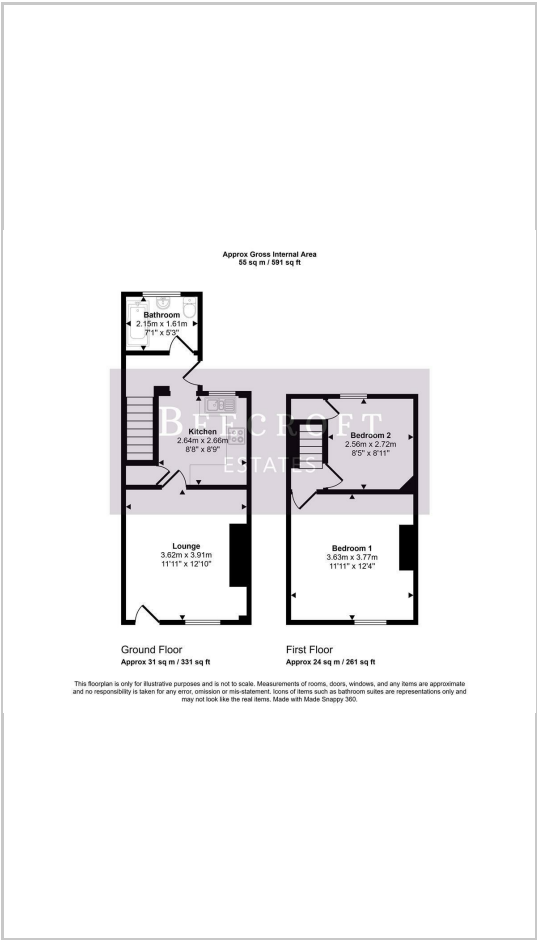
OUTSIDE

To the outside is a rear yard which is of a good size, offering a useful and private outdoor space.

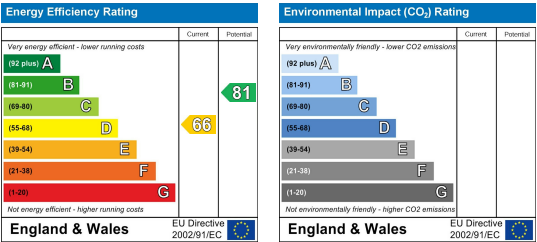
Area Map
