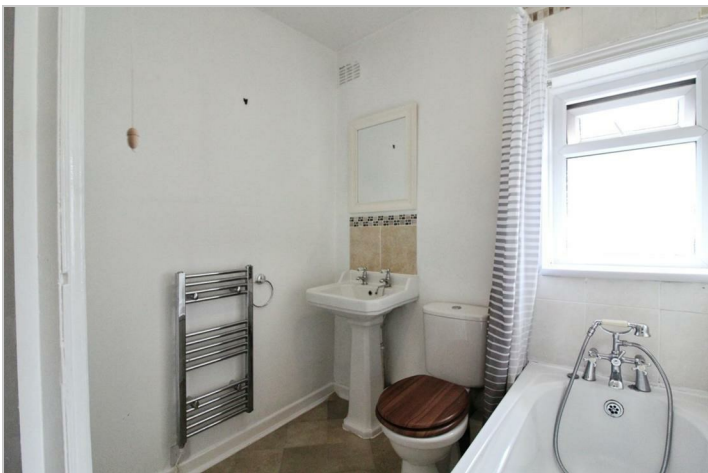

Terrain Map



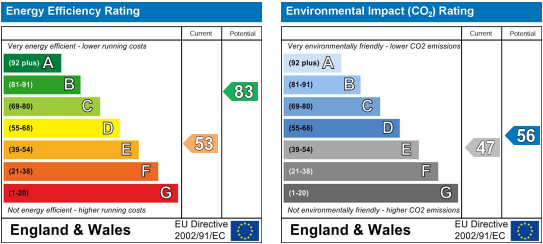
Floor Plan
