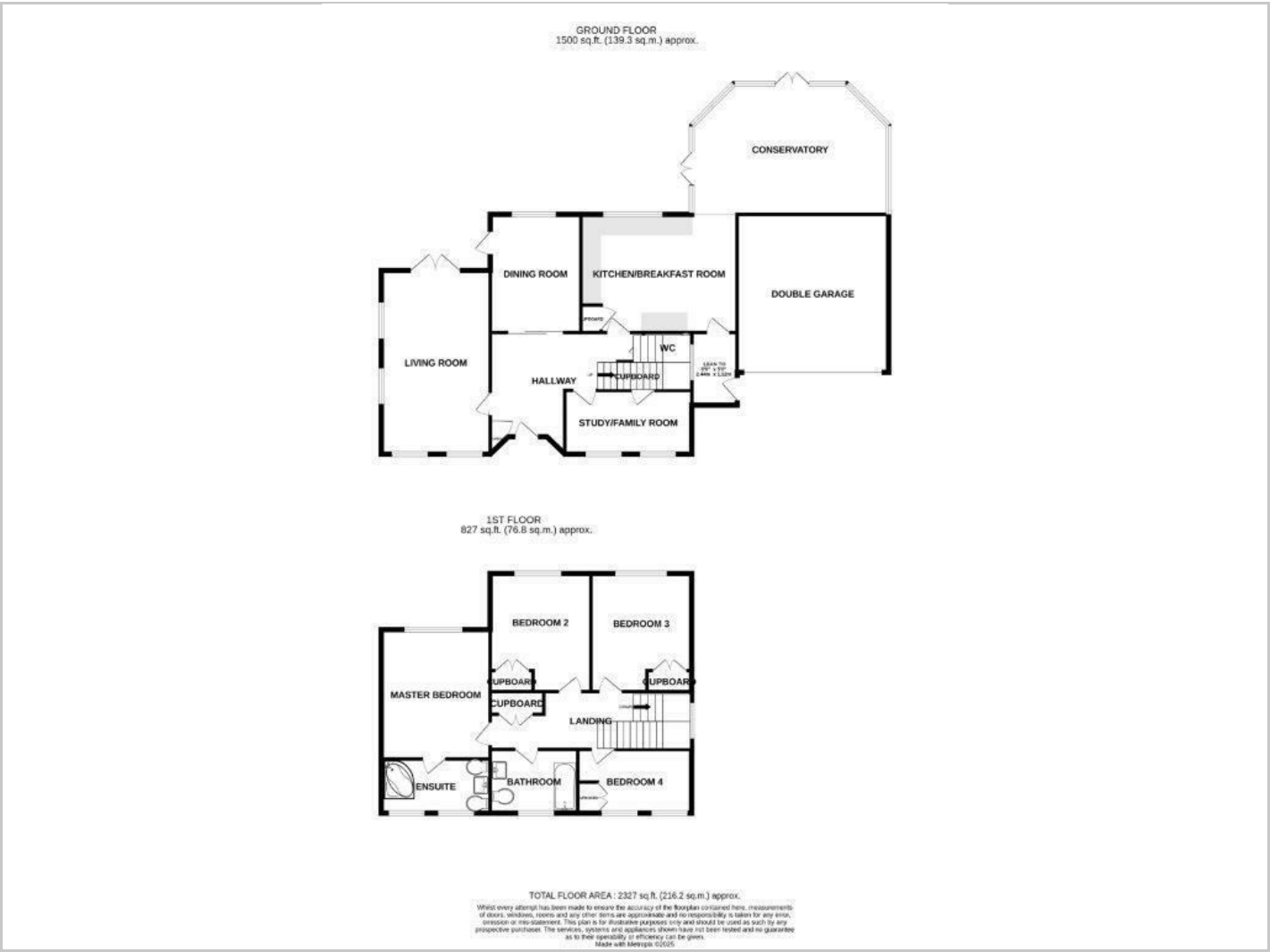

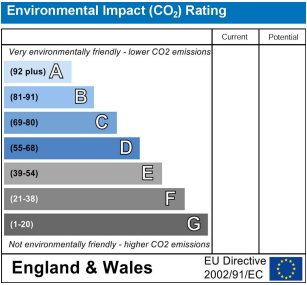
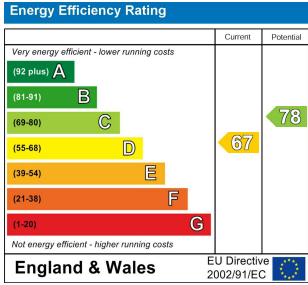
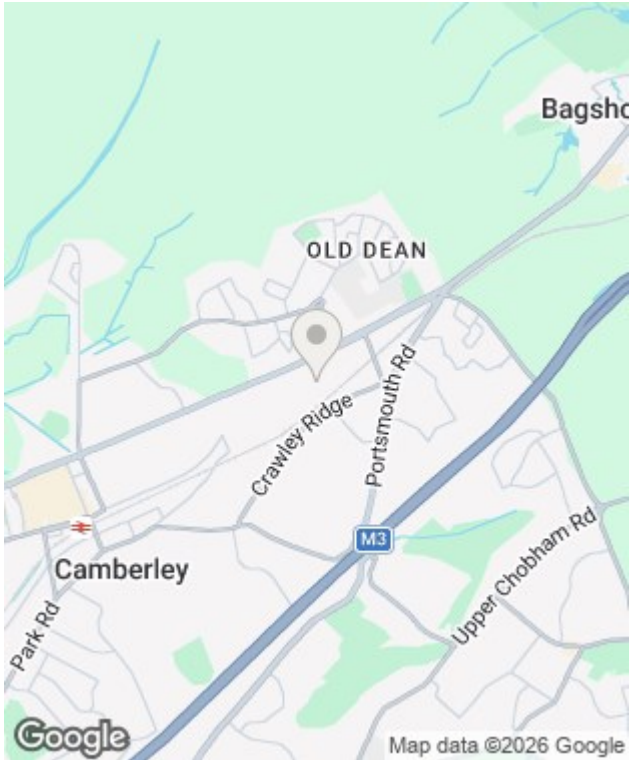




Floorplan
