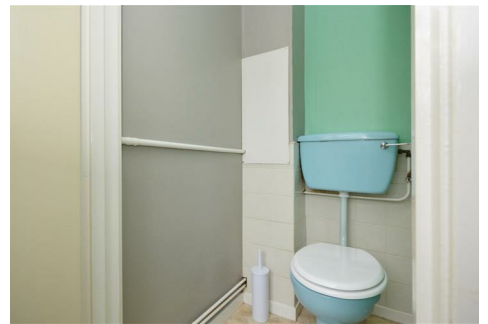




32 Bifield Gardens, Bristol, BS14 8TF

Bristol city centre is accessible by road, with bus services operating from the surrounding area towards central Bristol, Temple Meads and other key destinations. From Bristol Temple Meads, rail links connect to Bath in around 15 minutes and London Paddington in approximately 1 hour 40 minutes, subject to timetable. The Ring Road and major routes towards Bath and the wider South West are within driving reach, supporting commuting by car.

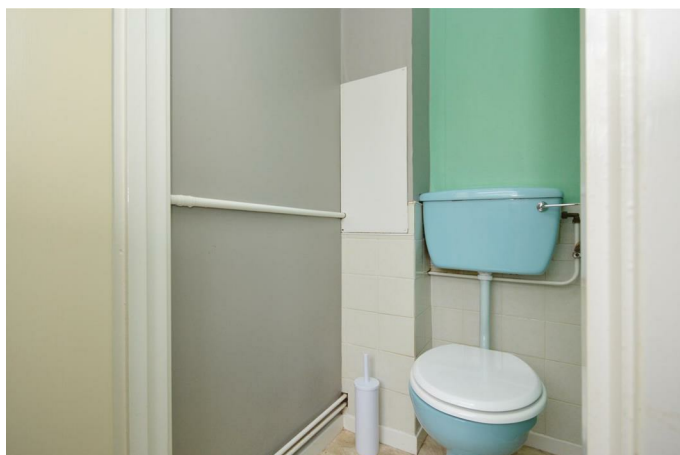

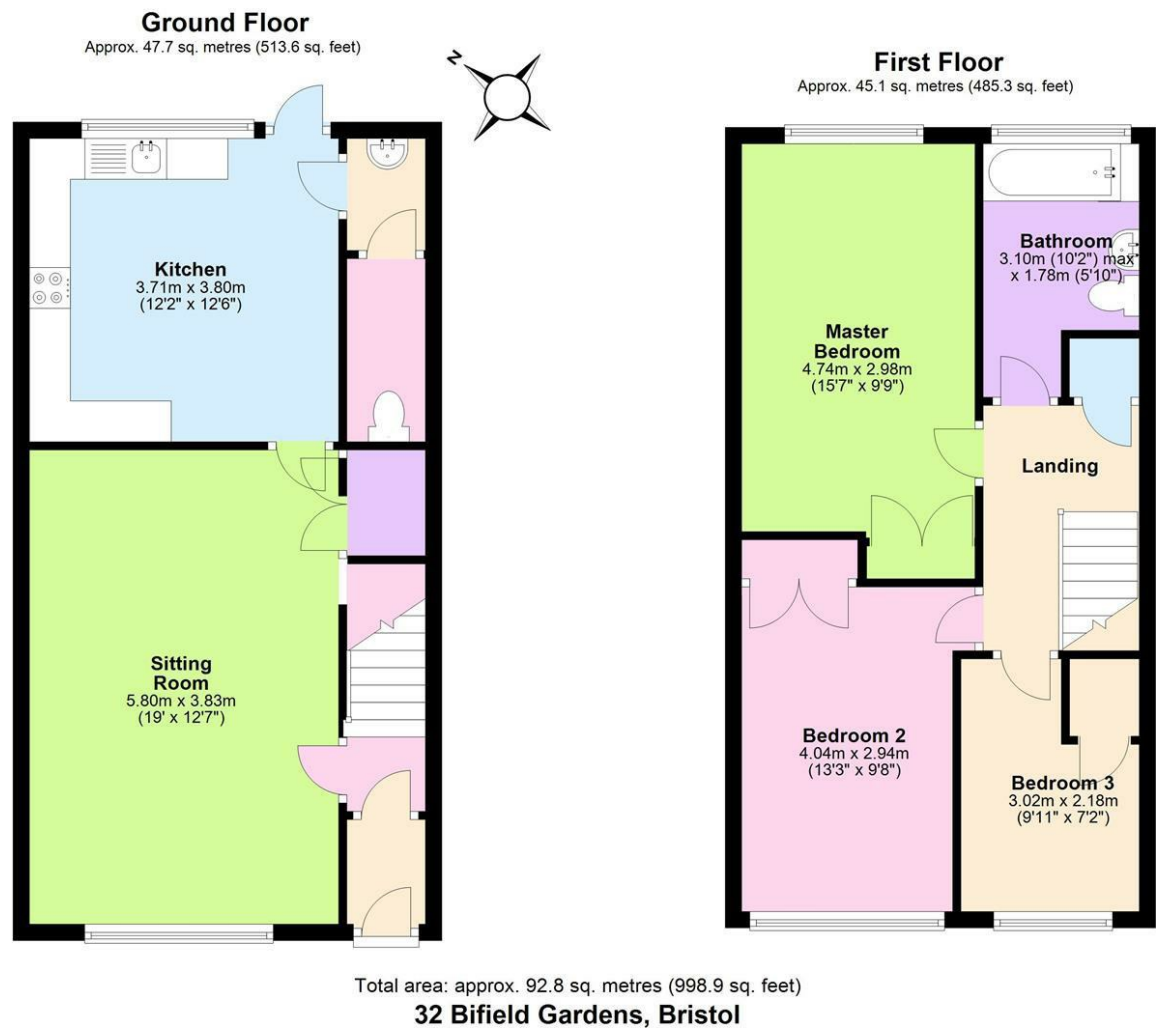

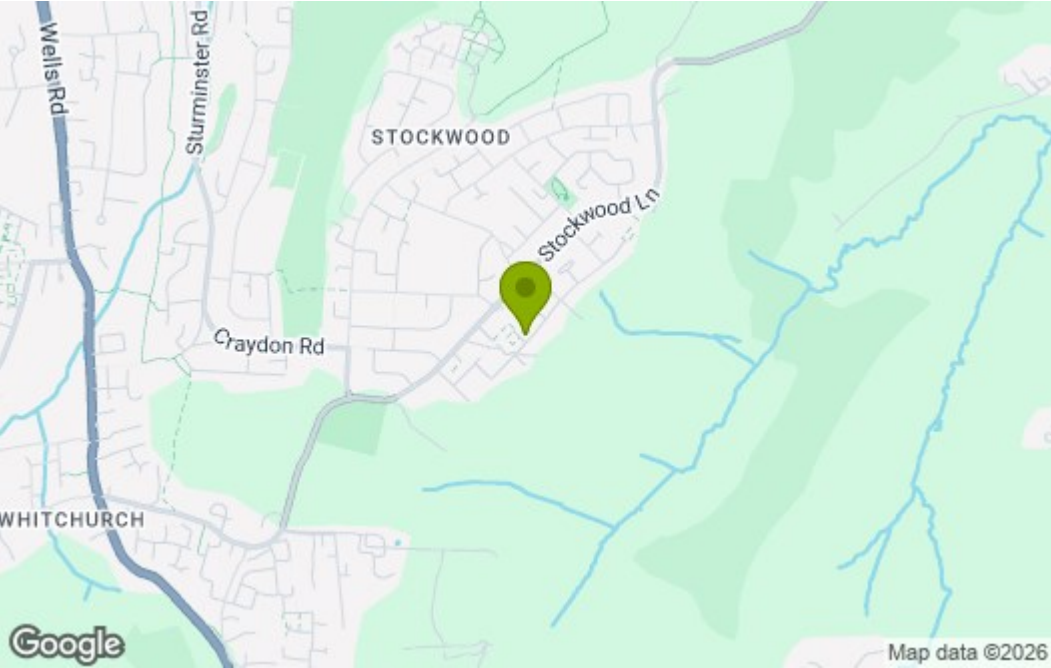

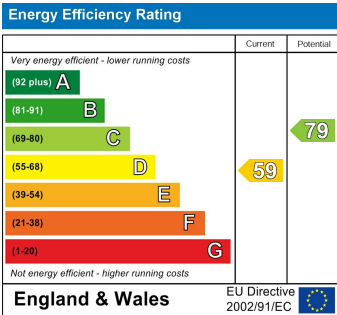
Floor Plan
