Porch

1.75m x 1.71m

UPVC double glazed entrance door to the front aspect and windows surround, wood effect laminate flooring throughout, a radiator and door opening to the sitting room.

Sitting Room

4.66m x 3.44m

UPVC double glazed window to the front aspect, wood effect laminate flooring throughout, a radiator, feature fireplace, and doors opening to the kitchen and hallway.



Kitchen

2.85m x 2.74m

UPVC double glazed window to the front aspect, and door to the side aspect opening to a lean-to which leads round to the rear garden.

Tile flooring throughout, a radiator, units above and below, laminate work surfaces, tiled splash back, a stainless steel sink with drainer, extractor fan with oven below, and space for appliances including a washing machine and fridge freezer.

Hall

Wood effect laminate flooring throughout, loft hatch, and doors opening to bedrooms 1-2, a storage cupboard housing the gas boiler and the shower room.

Shower Room

2.11m x 1.69m

UPVC double glazed window to the side aspect, vinyl flooring throughout, tiled walls, a radiator, toilet, vanity unit with inset hand wash basin and electric shower enclosed in a glass cubicle.



Bedroom 1

3.68m x 3.44m

UPVC double glazed window to the rear aspect, wood effect laminate flooring throughout, a radiator and doors opening to built-in wardrobes and drawers.

Bedroom 2/Dining Room

2.75m x 2.55m

A room which has the potential to be used as a second bedroom, dining room or home office. With French doors opening into a conservatory, wood effect laminate flooring throughout, a radiator and sliding doors opening into a building in wardrobe.

Conservatory

3.18m x 3.07m

Windows to the side and rear aspects with French doors opening into the garden, tile flooring throughout, a radiator and door opening to a built in storage cupboard.



Outside

To the front of the property steps lead down to a concrete pathway, small artificial lawn, and landscaped shingle patches, a timber gate opens to a lean to.

To the rear of the property a fully enclosed laid lawn garden with raised deck seating area and patio which houses two storage sheds.
