Externally, the property is set within a large gated plot with parking for numerous cars, mature planting and a large paved entertaining space. Planning permission has already been granted to further extend the kitchen and enlarge the en-suite bathroom, offering purchasers the opportunity to add further accommodation and value, should they wish.

The property is located within this rarely available quiet country lane, nestled amongst beautiful countryside, yet only a short distance from the village high street and amenities. The high sought after village of Much Hadham offers a thriving community and amenities which include an excellent village primary school, the renowned gastro village pub, village shop, doctors and a dentist to name a few. 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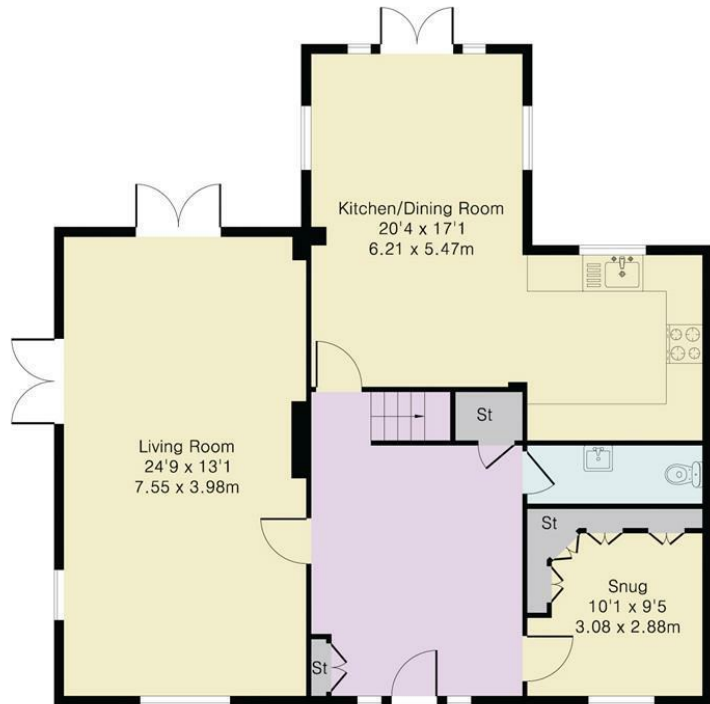


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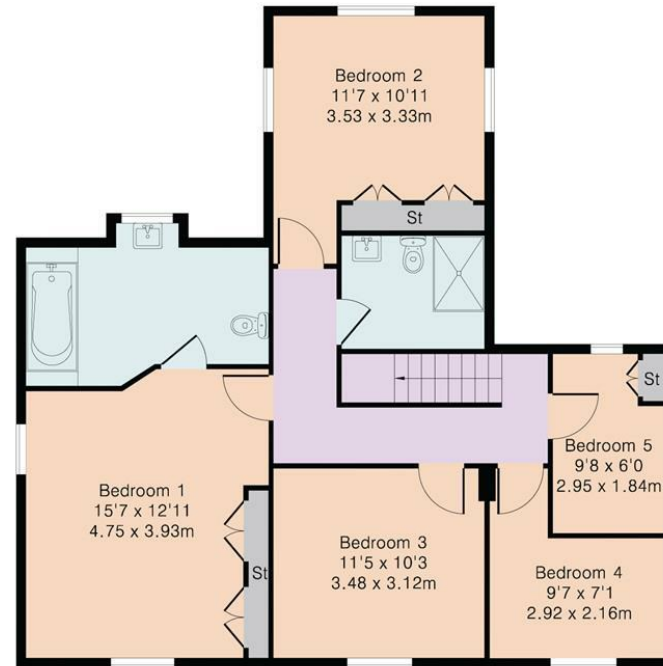
