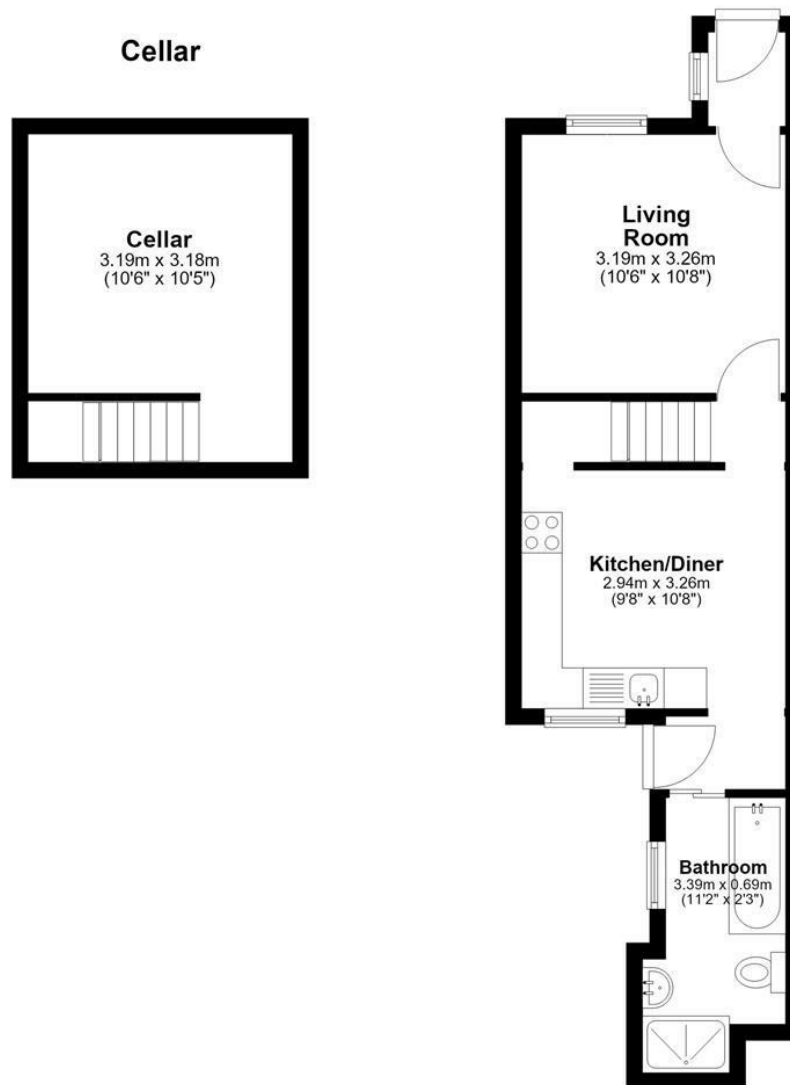

I will be sad to leave my home and the neighbours who have become close friends and a fabulous support network, but it's time for a new chapter in my life.

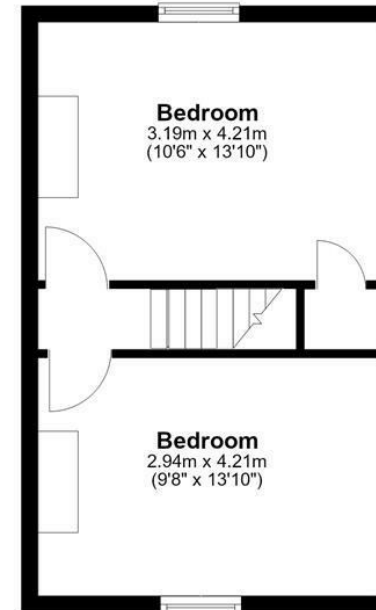


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Ground Floor
