The Property

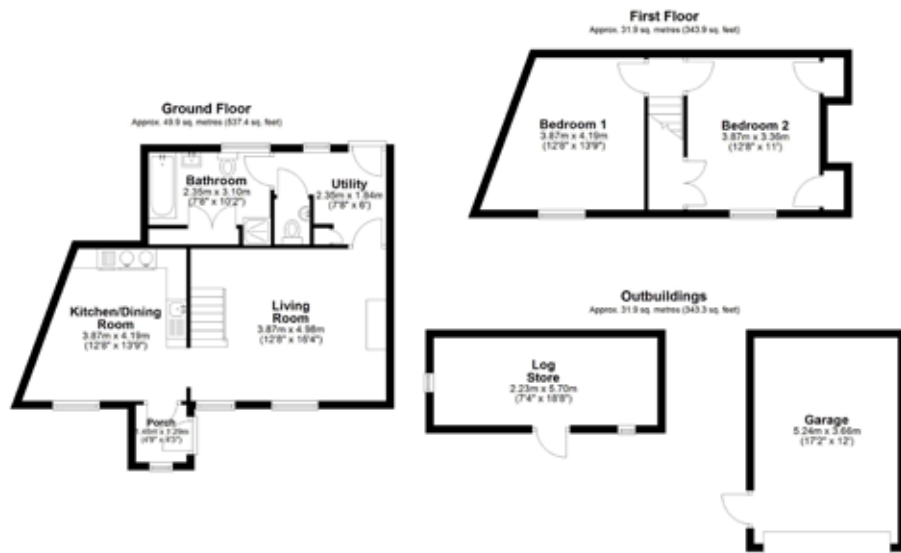
The beautiful stone cottage is set just on the fringe of the picturesque hamlet of Postbridge, right in the heart of Dartmoor. You are firstly invited to take off muddy walking boots in the convenient porch before being welcomed into the spacious kitchen/diner complete with a Rayburn and space to sit and enjoy a well earned cup of tea. The light and bright living room sits adjacent showing off its large granite fireplace and mantel, home to the log burner, perfect for those cosy winter nights. At the rear there is an extension, built in 2001, providing a space for the utilities, a WC, and a separate bathroom complete with bath, separate shower, and second WC. Upstairs there are two spacious double bedrooms, one with plenty of built in wardrobe space.



Outside

At the front of the property, and just over the public bridle path sits a good size walled plot belonging to the cottage. There is parking for multiple vehicles as well as a stone barn and a large single garage. At the rear of the garage sits a pretty moorland garden, mostly grassed with Devon banks surrounding. At the rear of the property is a small grassed triangle, accessed via the rear hall, a perfect space to hang a washing line.





Location

Postbridge is a small and picturesque hamlet set in the heart of Dartmoor. Surrounded by open moorland, rolling hills and dramatic granite tors, the village offers a peaceful rural setting with direct access to some of the South West's most striking natural scenery. Best known for its historic 13th-century clapper bridge spanning the East Dart River, Postbridge combines heritage charm with an enviable outdoor lifestyle. The area is ideal for walking, cycling and riding, with miles of open countryside on the doorstep. Along with its tranquil feel, it provides convenient road links to the larger towns of Princetown and Moretonhampstead, while Exeter and the A30 are within reasonable reach for commuting.
