Outside, the property benefits from a single garage and additional parking space, making it practical for families with multiple vehicles. The private road adds an extra layer of tranquillity, with a modest residence road fund of £120 per annum.

Situation

Croft Avenue offers a most convenient position allowing comfortable access to the town as well as the renowned Ashcombe School. All three of Dorking's Stations are within 0.75 of a mile and provide regular services to London, the south, east & west.

The town offers a fine selection of facilities including 5 supermarkets, an array of local and national shops which include Marks & Spencer, Fatface, Robert Dyas and Starbucks and Costa Coffee to mention just a few.

The Dorking Halls, which includes a cinema, theatre and the adjacent sports centre provides a great selection for those looking for entertainment and other leisure pursuits. There is a great selection of well regarded primary and secondary schools.

The immediate area provides some of the county's finest walking, running, cycling and riding countryside as highlighted in the 2012 Olympics and the 2013 Tour of Britain cycling events including Box Hill, Ranmore, Leith Hill and the Surrey Hills. Denbies, the country's largest vineyard, is just to the north of the town. The M25 can be accessed at Leatherhead and Reigate, respectively junctions 8 or 9.

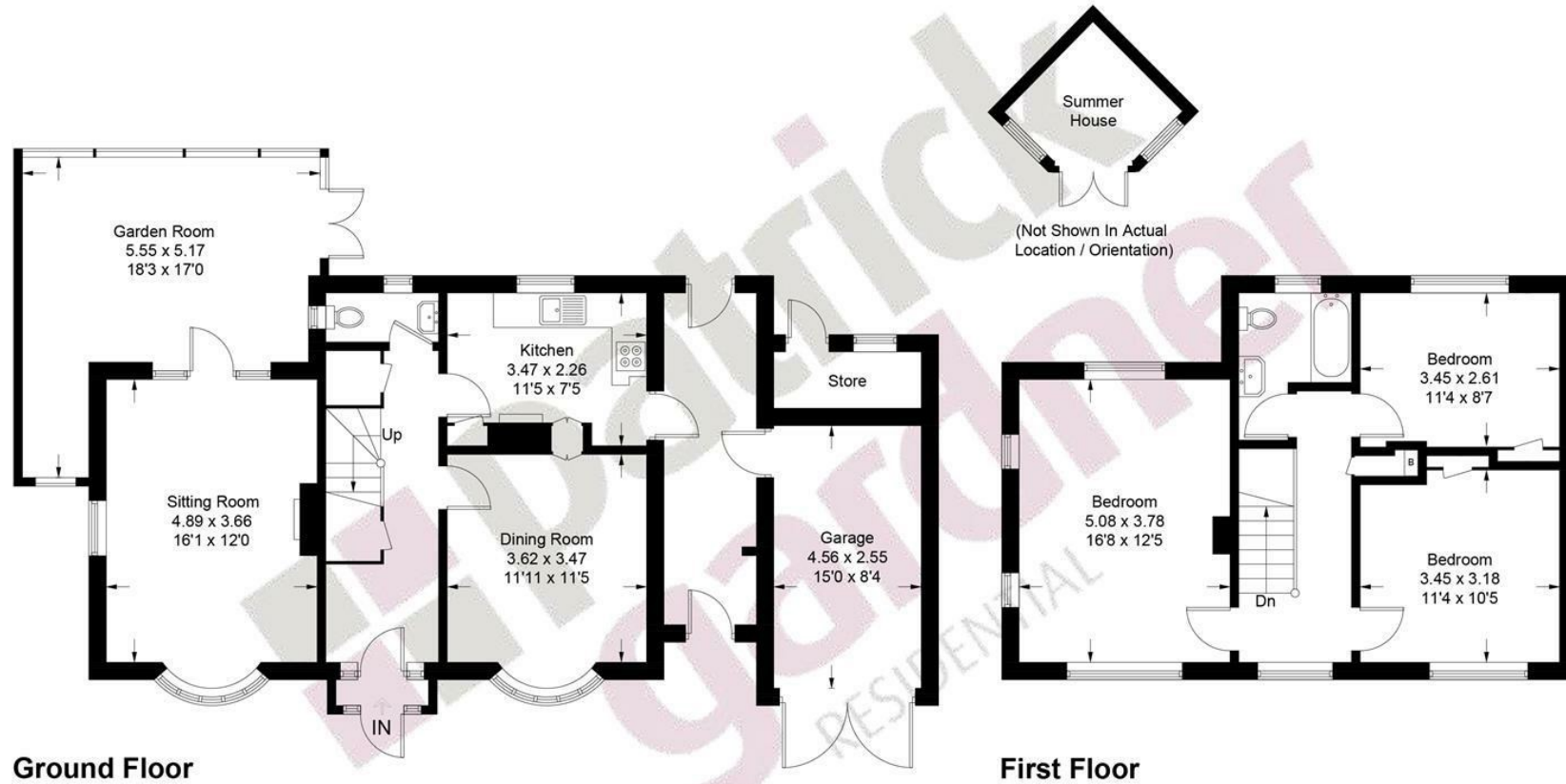
