Set within 3.4 acres of landscaped gardens and grounds, the property captures breathtaking views, while still being only a short drive from nearby villages as well as Bideford town centre, and the unspoiled beaches of North Devon.

From the moment you step inside, the farmhouse radiates warmth and sophistication. A welcoming entrance hall with a working fireplace and cosy reading nook sets the tone, leading into a thoughtfully designed interior where modern comforts meet period charm. The heart of the home is the bespoke hand-crafted kitchen, complete with granite worktops, a Rangemaster cooker, and a traditional larder, opening into a light-filled orangery with vaulted ceilings and garden views. From here, the formal dining room and expansive living room provide both elegance and comfort, boasting a wood burner, exposed stone walls, and windows that fill the space with natural light.







Completing the ground floor is a spacious utility and boot room - perfectly designed for country living and offering the ideal place to return to after exploring the grounds.

Upstairs, four elegantly appointed bedrooms, including a show-stopping master suite with vaulted ceilings, exposed beams, and a luxurious en suite bathroom, provide tranquil spaces to retreat and unwind with all bedrooms being double in size as well as an additional shower room on this floor.

From the courtyard, two enchanting cottages - Rose Cottage and The Old Dairy - extend the property's appeal. Designed with reverse-living layouts, both offer charming and versatile accommodation. Both cottages have proven popular as holiday rentals, enhancing the property's potential as both a home and an investment.

The grounds of Beara Farm are as impressive as the residences themselves.

A sweeping driveway leads to a gravelled parking area and a three-bay garage, while a large stone barn - already approved for conversion into a three-bedroom home - opens up further possibilities.

The gardens offer an idyllic mix of formal English lawns, a kitchen garden, wildflower meadows, and two pony paddocks, with a tranquil pond brimming with wildlife and fields ideal for equestrian use or smallholding.

A regular bus service provides access to North Devon's 'capital', Barnstaple. Bus users can also reach Westward Ho!, Braunton, Appledore, Croyde and Ilfracombe.
