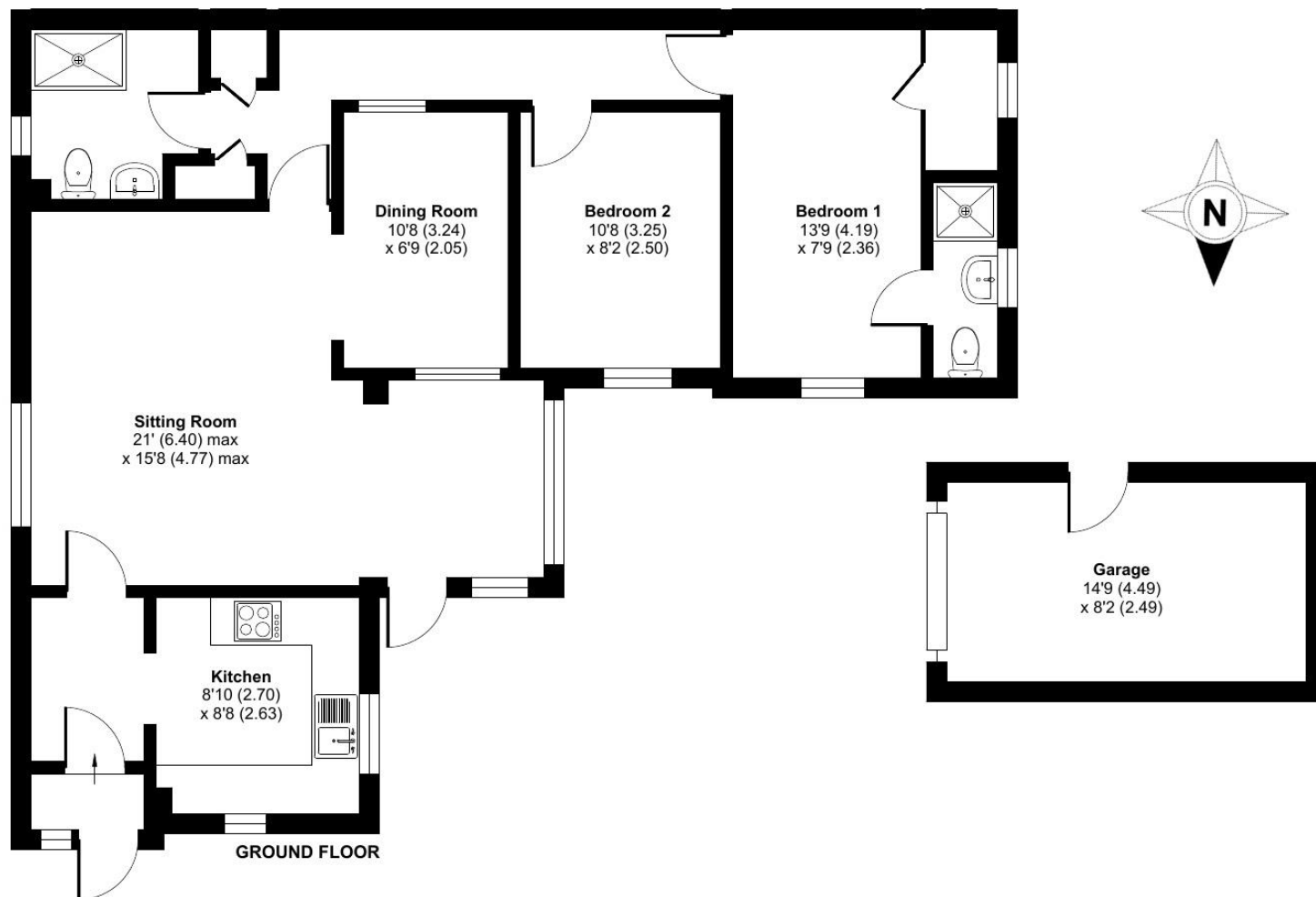

60 Barn Meads Road is a two bedroom (originally built as a three bedroom) bungalow situated on a quiet cul de sac with a garage and driveway parking.

The property comprises a neutral kitchen with plenty of wall and base units for storage, tiled splashbacks, a stainless steel sink, integrated single oven with an electric hob.
