HESSLE

ENTRANCE HALL

A welcoming entrance hall providing access to the accommodation with stairs and WC off.

WC

A vanity unit housing a WC and a wash hand basin. fitted storage cupboards and a window to the side elevation.

LIVING ROOM

A generous bay fronted living room with feature cast iron fireplace.

DINING ROOM

A versatile reception space with feature fireplace and French doors to the rear.

SITTING / BREAKFAST ROOM

Another versatile reception space ideal for a breakfast room or further sitting room with a bay window to the side elevation, feature cast iron fireplace and alcove fitted furniture.

DINING KITCHEN

A fabulous dining kitchen with green shaker wall and base units, contrasting laminated work surfaces and a breakfast bar. Integrated appliances include a

composite sink unit, cooker, extractor hood and an automatic washing machine. Further benefitting from tiled flooring, 4 sky lights, recessed spotlights, French doors to the rear elevation and ample dining space.
