SITUATION

Bartletts Field Barn is situated in an attractive rural location in North Devon, surrounded by farm land and woodland yet only 2 miles to the east of Bideford, a former port town on the banks of the River Torridge.

The coastal villages of Instow, Appledore and Northam are all within a short drive and the larger town of Barnstaple lies 10 miles to the north-east.

DESCRIPTION

Bartletts Field Barn is set within 4.19 acres (1.70 hectares) and is approached from the public highway over a private entrance drive.

The barn is a modern barn (timber frame) which has planning consent in place (class Q) for its conversion to a residential dwelling.

The existing building measures 26.75m x 9.50m (max) with a lean-to (13.39m x 4.66m). There is an adjoining open fronted store (5.75m x 2.91m).

The approved accommodation on the ground floor includes an open plan living, dining and kitchen space, a separate sitting

room, an entrance lobby, a utility room, a home office and a bedroom which has an en-suite bathroom and dressing room.

On the first floor the plans are for four double bedrooms, two of which are to have en-suite shower rooms, plus a further shower room.

Outside there is provision for a garden and parking, beyond which is the gently sloping grass field which borders mature woodland on the north-eastern boundary.

SERVICES

There are no services currently connected. Purchasers will need to install their own private drainage system. We understand that mains water may be available in the adjoining road.

PLANNING

Planning consent (class Q) was approved by Torridge District Council on the 28th July 2025, subject to conditions.

The planning reference is 1/0383/2025/AGMB and full plans and documents relating to the planning application are available on Torridge District Councils website.

Proceed for one mile and at the roundabout take the first exit onto Alverdiscott Road. Continue for 0.7 miles and the entrance to Bartletts Field Barn will be on the left.

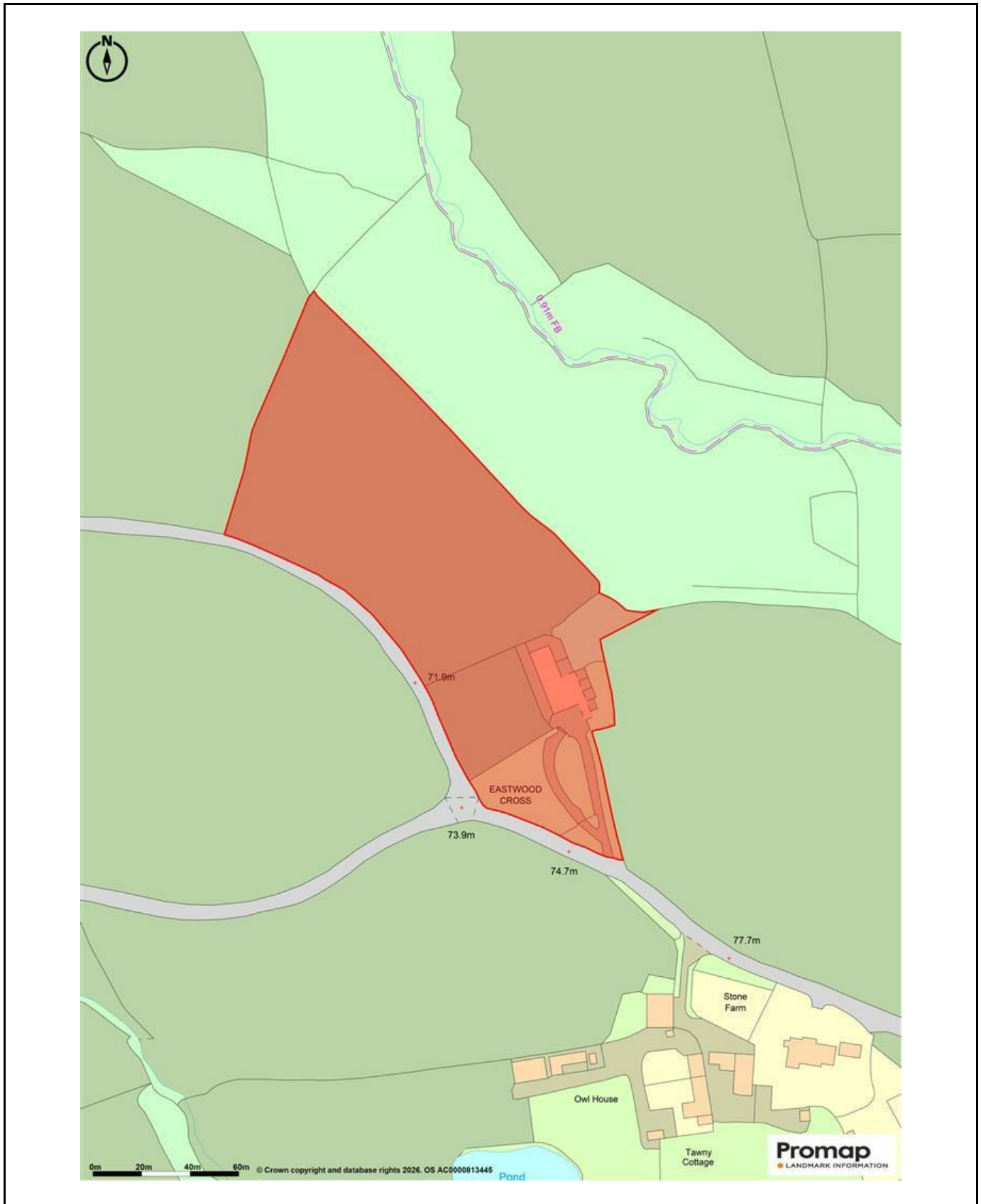
