The cottage boasts a focal point woodburning stove and there are also modern electric storage heaters. An attractive kitchen offering a range of wall and base units including a dishwasher, fridge/freezer, electric oven, hob and freestanding washing machine. A door to the rear allows access to the side of the cottage and the public footpath.

Upstairs, the landing leads to a well appointed shower room, with recessed shower cubicle and electric shower, WC and vanity wash basin. The good sized double bedroom has a large built-in wardrobe and window to side enjoying village and rural views.

Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town located on the edge of the Dartmoor National Park. The town offers a wide range of local and national shops whilst also boasting the renowned pannier market, riverside park, leisure centre and theatre. 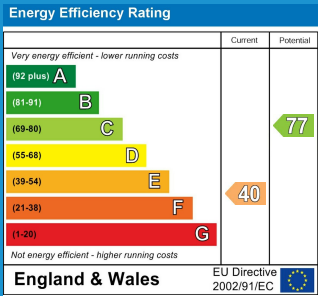
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Area Map
