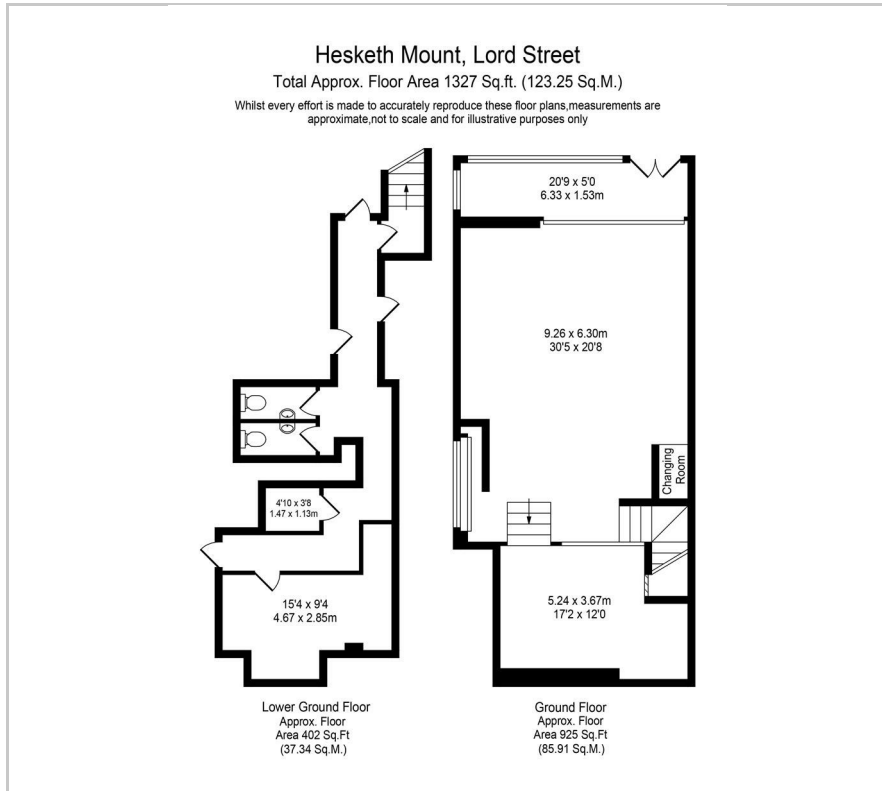

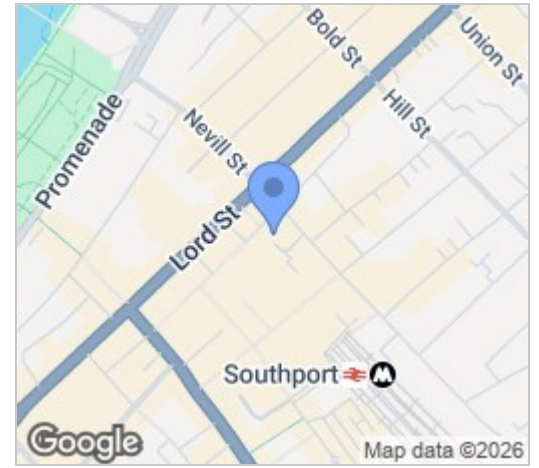

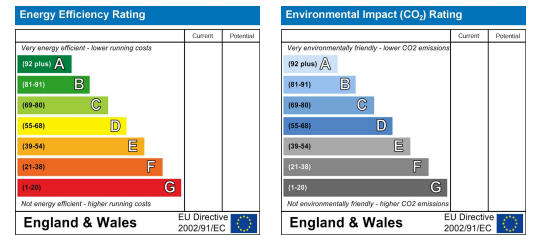
Floor Plan
