The accommodation is both stylish and spacious. A front entrance hallway leads into an impressive light-filled front living room with bay, sash window, feature fireplace and bespoke fitted cabinetry.

To the rear is a stunning open kitchen dining room, complete with further bespoke fitted furniture, Belfast sink, a second feature fireplace, and French doors leading into a small picturesque courtyard. Beyond the kitchen is a utility with space for further appliances, sink with waste disposal unit and the boiler.

Upstairs, the first floor offers two spacious double bedrooms with character features and fire places, as well a five piece bathroom. To the second floor is the third bedroom which is another fabulous size, flooded with natural light from the dual aspect.

Externally, there is a small courtyard garden to the front and residents' on-street parking. Houses on Newton terrace are rarely available and this sure to attract attention.

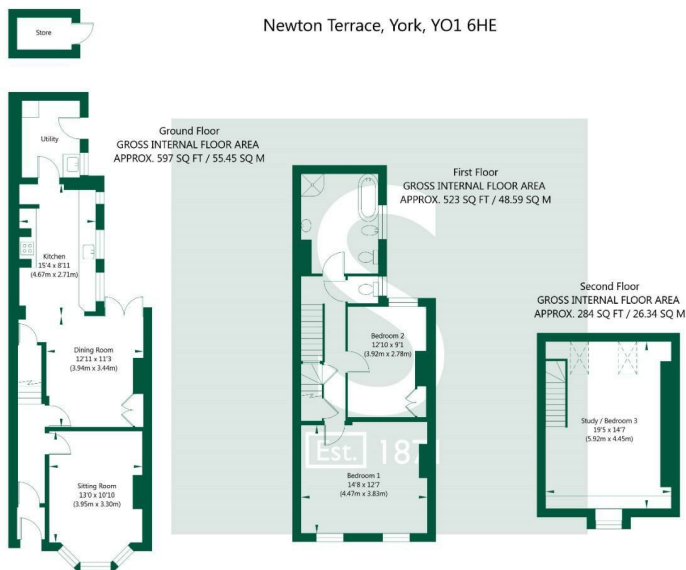
