With radiator, telephone point and understairs storage cupboard.

Space for tall fridge/freezer, space and plumbing for washing machine, built in four ring gas hob with electric oven under and stainless steel extractor hood over. Cupboard housing Worcester gas boiler.

To the rear of the house with bi-fold doors providing direct access to the rear garden. Radiator, dimmer switch and tv aerial connection.

With access to roof storage space.



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
