To the first floor are three well-proportioned bedrooms and a family bathroom.

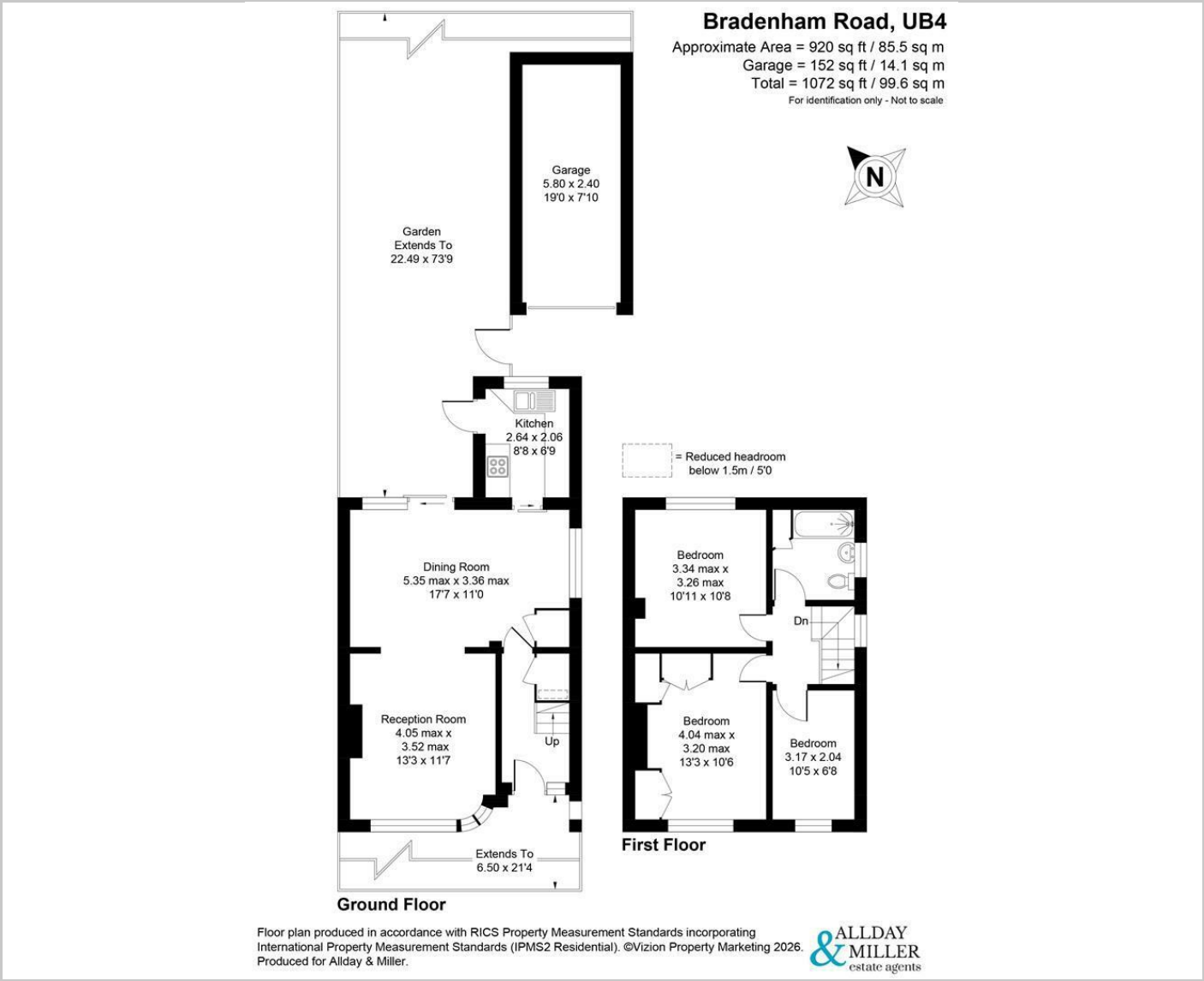
Externally, the property benefits from a well-maintained rear garden, a driveway providing off-road parking, and a garage.

Situation

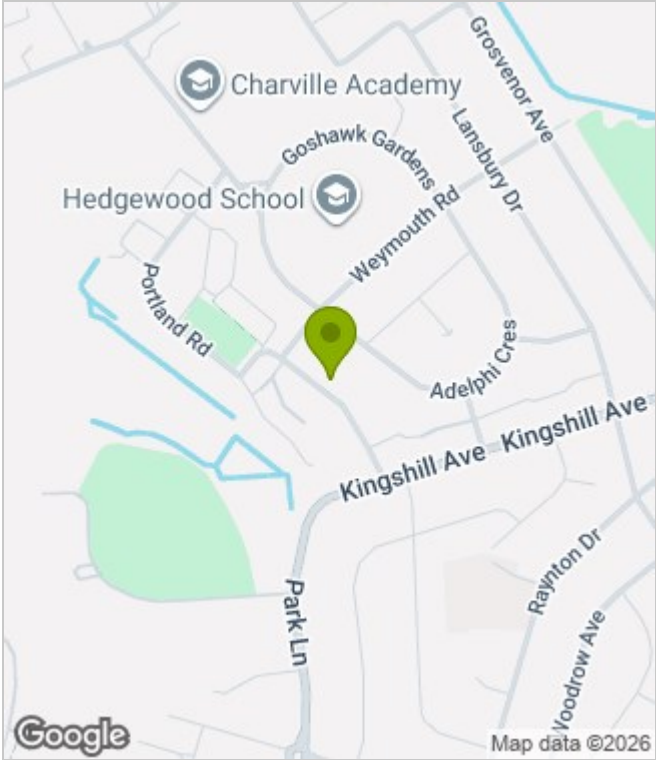

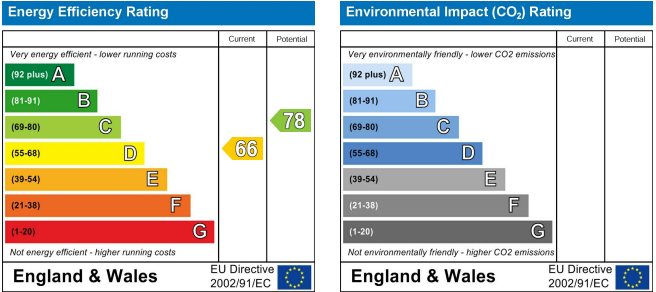
Floor Plans
