Ideal for the first time/young family buyer or someone looking to downsize.

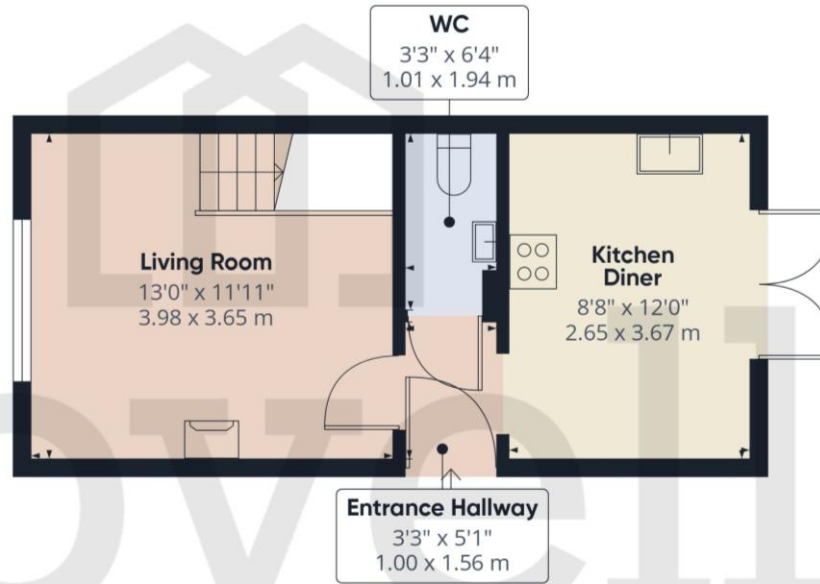

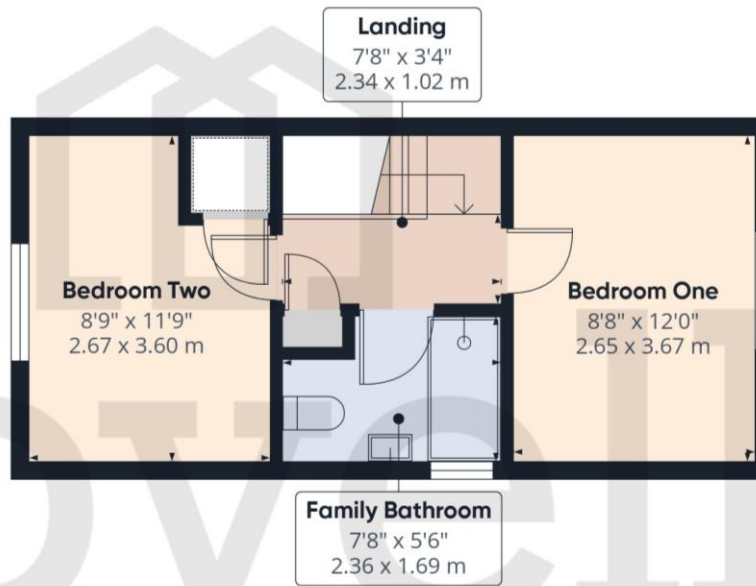
