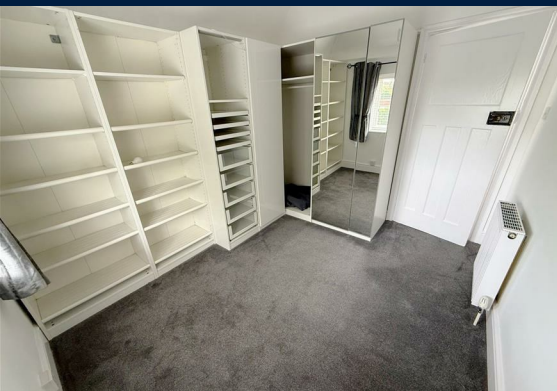
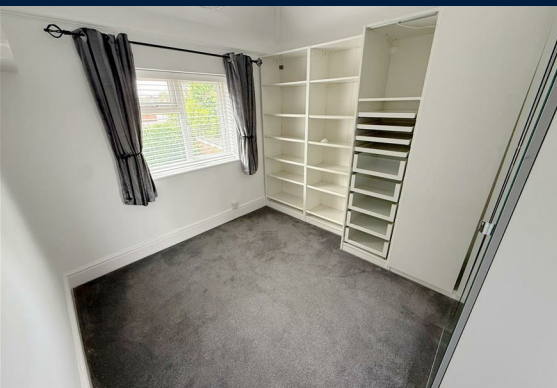
Situated in a popular cul-de-sac within easy walking distance of Stratford upon Avon town centre, this well-presented two-bedroom semi-detached home is offered for sale with no onward chain, making it an excellent opportunity for first-time buyers, downsizers or investors.

The accommodation begins with a welcoming entrance hallway leading through to a bright and spacious dual-aspect living room, featuring an attractive fireplace and patio doors opening onto the rear garden, creating a lovely connection between the indoor and outdoor living spaces. The kitchen is fitted with a range of wall and base units and integrated appliances. The ground floor also benefits from useful understairs storage cupboard.

Upstairs, the property offers a particularly generous dual-aspect principal bedroom, flooded with natural light, alongside a second smaller double bedroom, currently arranged as a dressing room, and a family bathroom.

Outside, the rear garden has been designed for low-maintenance enjoyment, with a lawned area and patio terrace providing an ideal space for relaxing or entertaining. A real highlight is the rear gate, which opens directly onto the canal towpath, offering a pleasant walk and convenient access into the town centre. To the front of the property, a driveway provides off-road parking for two vehicles.

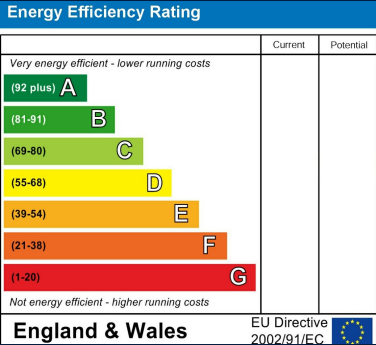
Floor Plan
