This popular style of one bedroom apartment (Type 20) is situated on the fourth floor comprising of "L" shaped reception room with views of the Dome of St Paul's, re-fitted kitchen, original Barbican bathroom, separate cloakroom and bedroom overlooking the residents gardens. Parking, bike cages and storage lockers are available to rent by separate negotiation with the City of London Corporation. Approx 750 sqft (69.7 sqm)



The bedroom is at the rear of the property, with fitted wardrobes and a full height window and door leading to a balcony overlooking the peaceful residents' gardens.

The service charge includes background underfloor heating, 24 hour portage in the car parks and private residents' gardens.

This property has direct lift access to the residents' garden below the building.

The Barbican Estate includes the Barbican Arts Centre, cinemas, art gallery, concert hall, theatre, restaurants, bars and cafes and a conservatory. A full size Waitrose and Marks & Spencer food and clothing store are nearby.

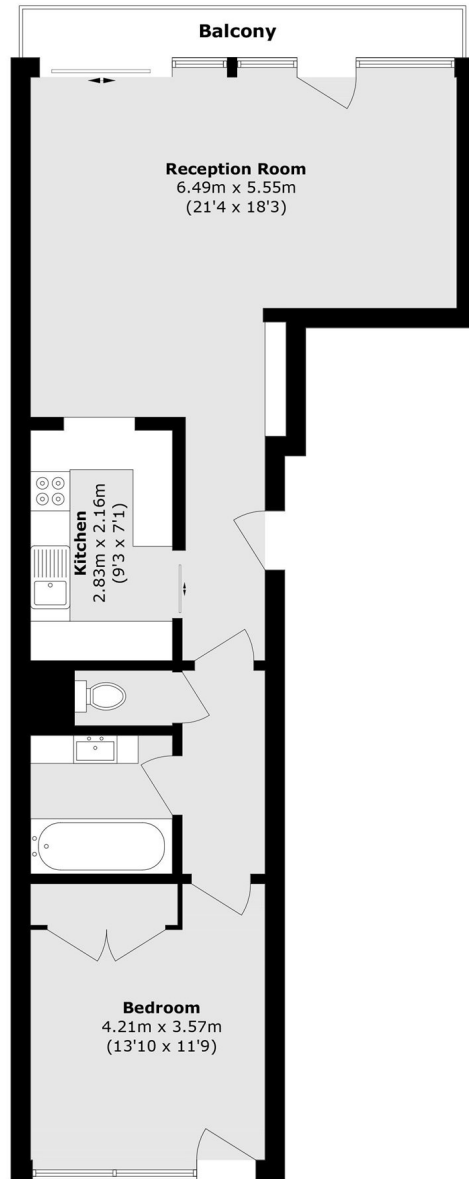
