

Access from the hall leads down to the basement where there is one principle areas together with a number of ancillary rooms.

Up at first floor are three truly 'double' sized bedrooms with an en suite shower room to the primary bedroom, and a gorgeous main bathroom with the original bath re enamelled.

Up again, see photos 26 & 27, and the bright wide landing area to the converted loft area is shown. This we have not considered as a genuine fourth bedroom, nor have we added it as such within our Guide Price, for this whole conversion of loft space does not come with building regulations approval. It is clearly very nicely presented space and comes with additional storage to the landing recessed eaves area.

Referring back to the refurbishment, we would highlight some of those improvements/additions: This includes a cottage style, double glazed sash window system; new central heating and new electrics. The kitchen and bathroom installations are obviously 'near to new' being just two years old; so to the décor, loft conversion, décor, floor coverings etc
