

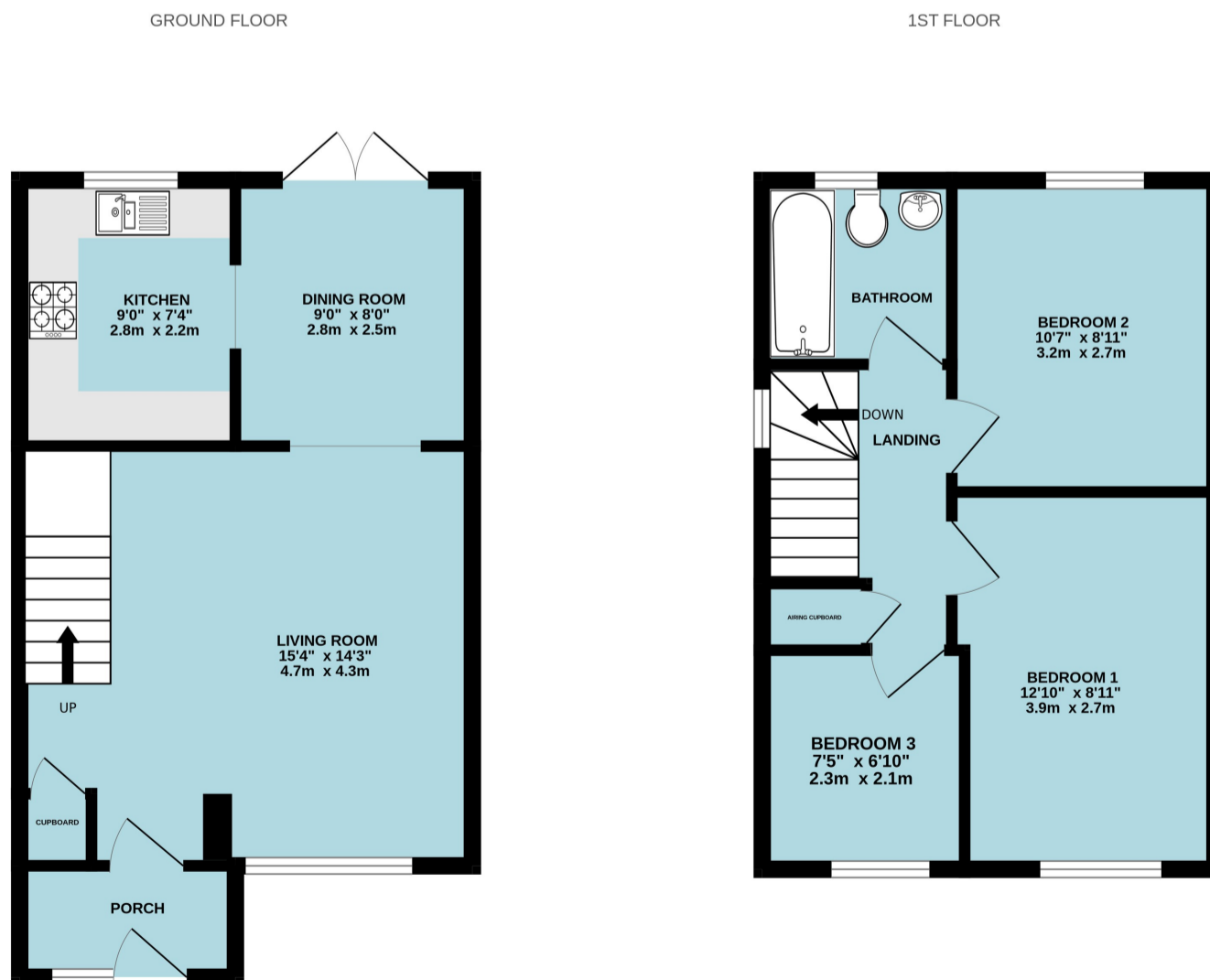

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Description

Kilburn Drive is a three bedroom semi-detached property situated on the popular Bower Manor development. The dwelling would benefit from some updating throughout and has a garage and a carport together with off-road parking.

The house is offered to the market with vacant possession and no onward chain.

THE PROPERTY:

The accommodation comprises an entrance porch, a living room with stairs rising to the first floor and a dining area with patio doors opening to the rear garden. The kitchen has a range of base and wall units, space for a cooker, a fridge and plumbing for a washing machine.

To the first floor are three bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Outside – As previously stated, there is off-road parking leading to the garage, a carport and a lawned garden. The garden to the rear is predominantly laid to lawn and is a blank canvas with a very small decking area.

The property also has side access and has electric heating throughout.

LOCATION:

The property is situated on the east side of Bridgwater with good access to junction 23 of the M5 motorway without passing through the town itself. The Bower Manor development boasts its own shopping facilities plus takeaway outlets and a regular bus service to the town. The property is situated approximately 1.5 miles from the town centre that offers an excellent range of facilities including retail, educational and leisure amenities. Bridgwater offers a regular bus service to Taunton, Weston-super-Mare and Burnham-on-Sea. There is a daily coach service to London Hammersmith from Bridgwater Bus Station. Main line links are available from Bridgwater Railway Station.
