Castlehill sits in the Heart of Castle o'er Forest in Eskdalemuir and has many paths and trails perfect for the outdoor enthusiast including cycling, horse riding, fishing and walking. The village of Eskdalemuir is approximately 2 miles North and is probably best known for the Eskdalemuir Observatory and for the Samye Ling Tibetan Buddhist monastery. The Eskdalemuir Hub is situated in the village and has a welcoming café, bar and village shop. It hosts a number of different community events and also has an exhibition hall. The town of Langholm is around 14 miles to the south and Lockerbie lies around 14 miles to the west.


