Full of character and individuality, this versatile property offers an exceptional amount of accommodation for the price and is currently run successfully as an Airbnb, providing an attractive income opportunity.

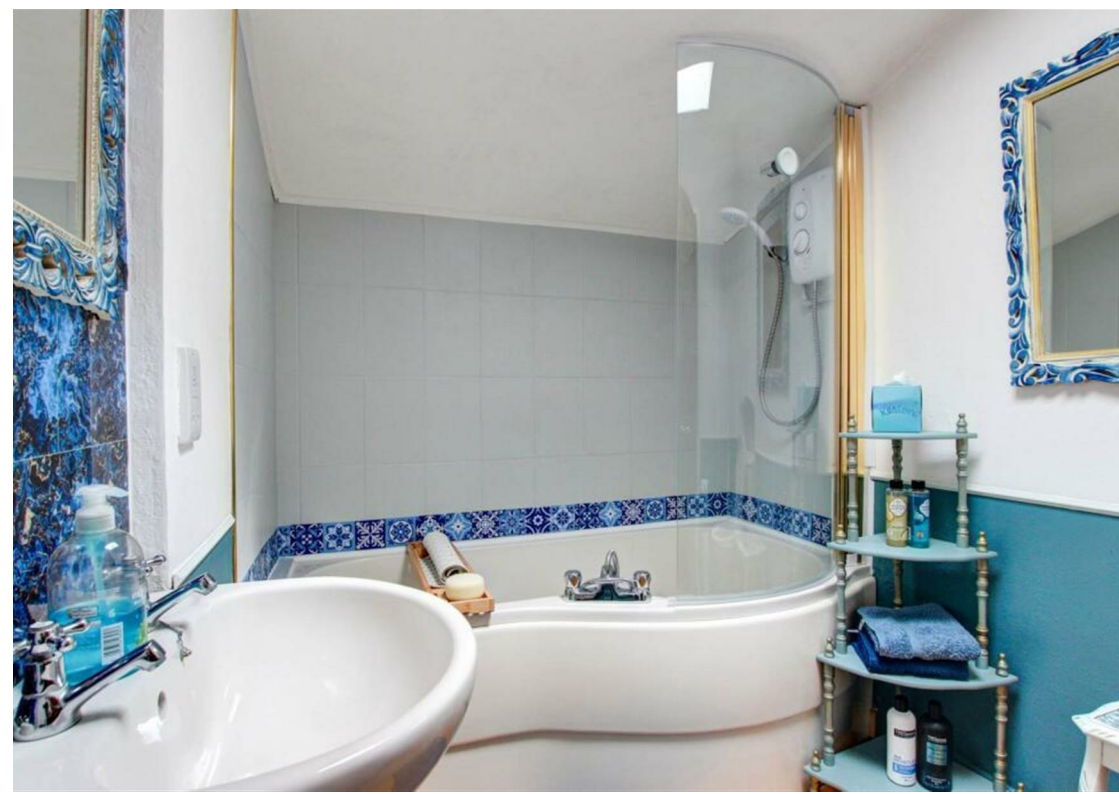

The property is of non-standard construction and is therefore offered to cash buyers only. Viewings are strictly by appointment on Mondays only for confirmed cash purchasers.

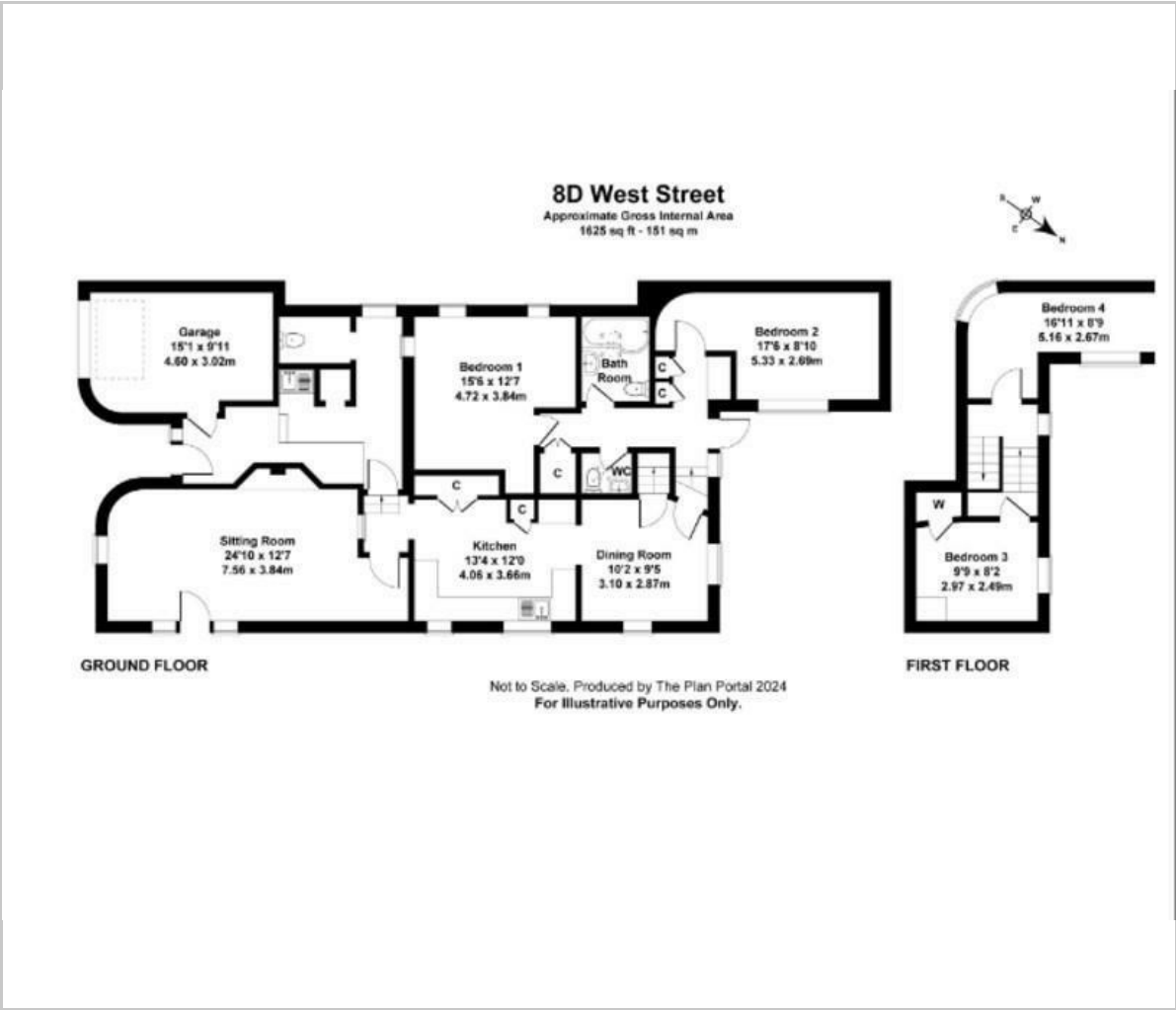

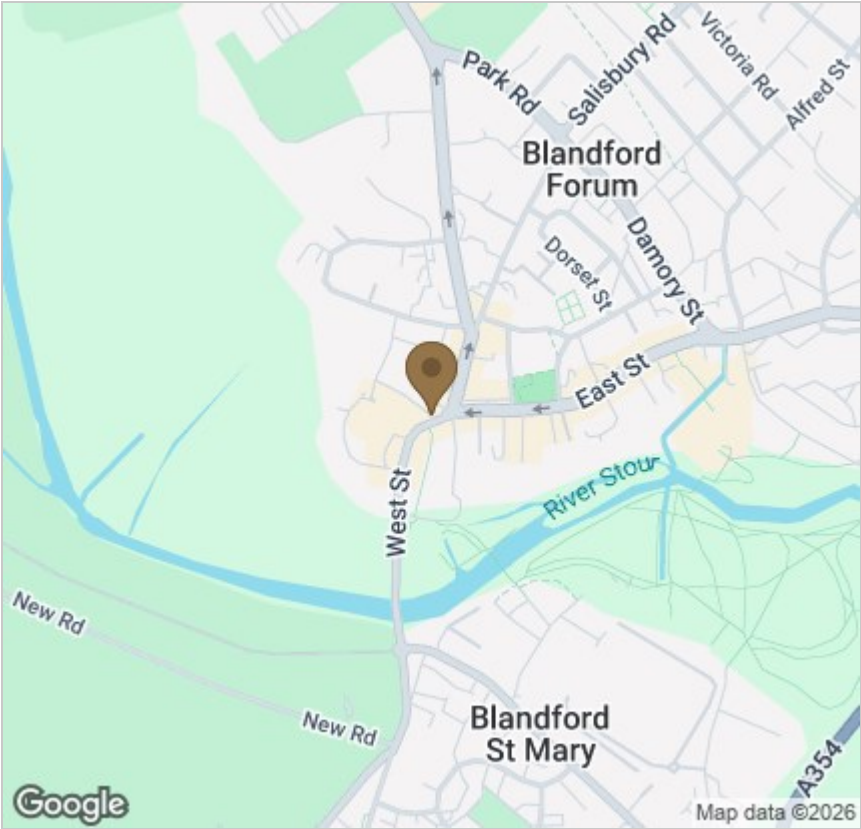




Floor Plan
