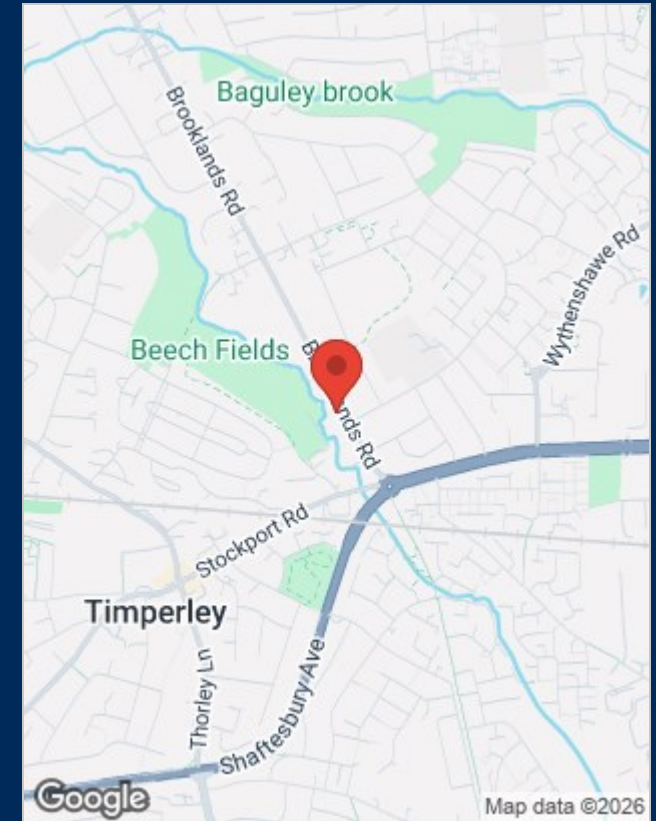




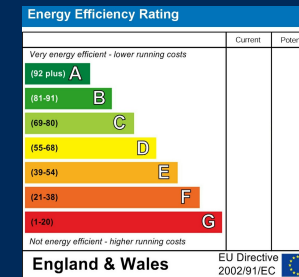
Floor Plans
