


Floor Plan

Tucked away at the far end of a quiet cul-de-sac, this 1970s end-terrace home enjoys an enviable and private position, screened behind mature greenery and overlooking St Clements Park. Offered for sale with no onward chain, the property presents an excellent opportunity for a quick sale.

The accommodation begins with a porch entrance leading into a spacious L-shaped sitting room/dining room, complimented by large double glazed windows which flood the room with natural light. A modern fitted kitchen sits to the rear of the property, complemented by a conservatory that enjoys views over the garden. A generous under-stairs storage cupboard completes the ground floor.

Upstairs, there are three well-proportioned bedrooms accessed from the landing, along with a family bathroom and a useful airing cupboard.

Externally, the property benefits from a low-maintenance rear garden with side access. In addition, there is a garage measuring approximately 4.8m x 2.5m, with a new roof installed in late 2025.
