



A striking frontage with a traditional bay window gives the house a strong, welcoming presence from the street, with period detailing adding character and charm. Step inside and the hallway leads you through to a beautifully inviting reception room where wood flooring and an exposed brick chimney breast create a striking focal point. The bay window draws in soft daylight through shutters that balance privacy with style, setting the tone for a space that feels both elegant and wonderfully comfortable.

To the rear, the kitchen and dining room opens into a generous, social hub designed for modern life. An island sits naturally at its heart, while continuous wood flooring brings warmth and flow from end to end. A skylight overhead enhances the sense of space, and doors opening directly onto the garden make entertaining and everyday living feel effortlessly connected.

Outside, the long south-facing garden enjoys sunshine throughout the day and offers an impressive stretch of outdoor space. Whether enjoyed as it is or gently styled over time, it provides a lovely setting for all fresco dining, relaxing or simply unwinding on a summer evening.

Upstairs, the landing connects the rooms comfortably and includes scope to explore a future loft conversion, subject to the usual permissions. The principal bedroom is

generous and full of character with exposed brick detailing, while the rear bedroom offers a calm, restful setting. The bathroom completes the floor with both a bath and separate shower, finished in soft tiling and patterned flooring for a luxurious, spa-like feel.

Life here extends well beyond the front door, with plenty to enjoy just moments away. The Forest Gate Railway Arches have developed into a vibrant local hub, home to the likes of Ramble Café for weekend brunches, Giovanna's Deli & Wine for Italian-inspired treats and bottles to take home, and Joyau for relaxed dining with an open-kitchen feel. The Holly Tree offers a welcoming spot for an easy pint or supper, while the wide open space of Wanstead Flats provides a refreshing escape for walks and fresh air. Families are well catered for too, with highly regarded schools nearby, including Buxton Primary School, just under a ten-minute walk away.

WHAT ELSE?

For commuters, both Forest Gate Station and Wanstead Park Station are around a ten-minute walk away, offering speedy connections into the City, Docklands and beyond. Whether heading into town for work or out at the weekend, having two stations so close by makes travelling feel straightforward and flexible, with easy access to several key routes across London right on your doorstep.
