The living room opens into a well fitted kitchen area with integrated fridge/freezer and dishwasher. Built-in electric double oven with inset microwave above. Electric hob with extractor over. From the living room a door leads to the hallway with door into a double bedroom with built-in bedroom furniture and a well equipped bathroom with bath and newly installed shower over.

The property benefits a recently carried out electrical test report and is economical to heat with night storage and panel heaters.

The gardens are well tended with various seating areas to enjoy the sunshine.

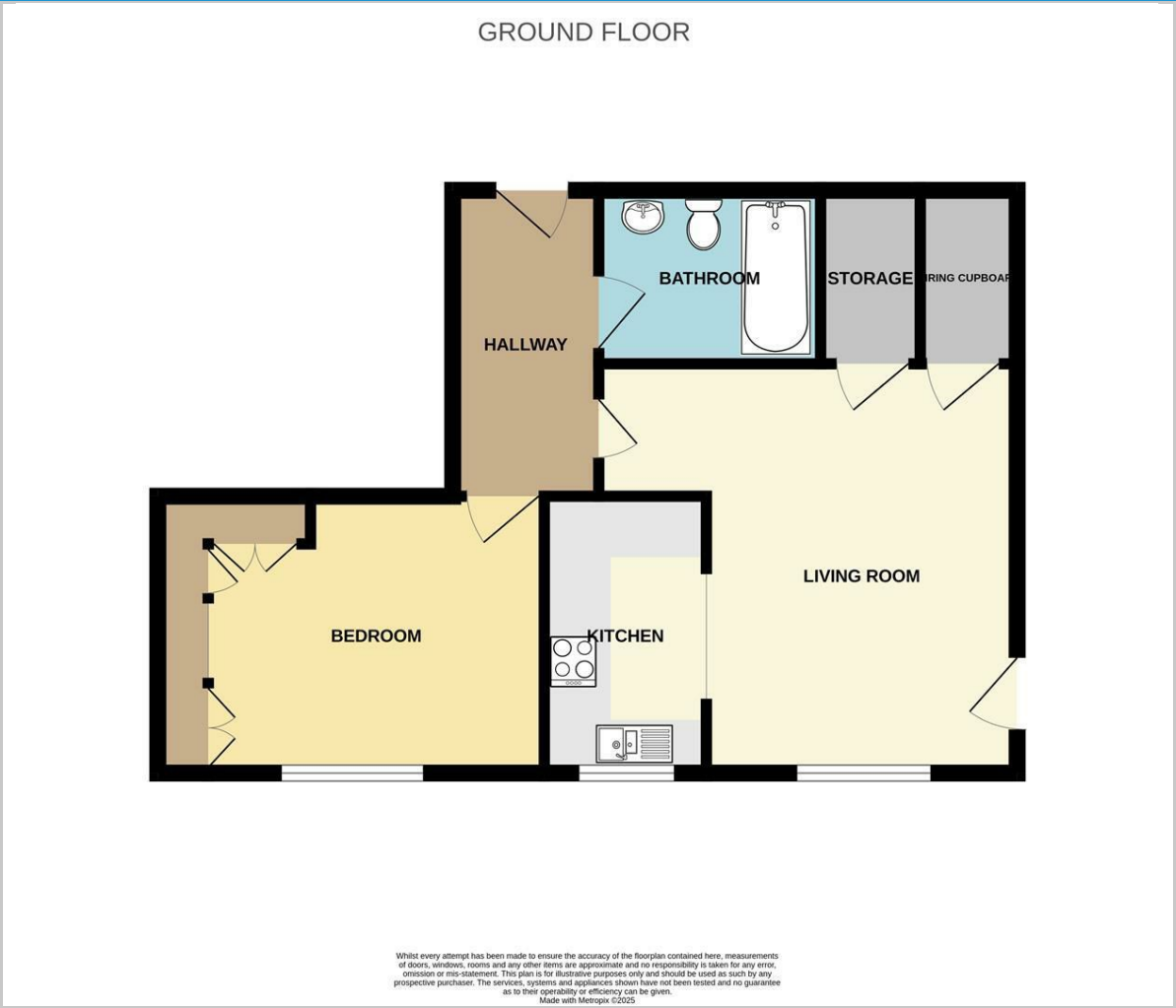
Tavistock is an ancient stannary and market town located on the edge of the Dartmoor National Park. The town offers a wide range of local and national shops whilst also boasting the renowned pannier market, riverside park, leisure centre and theatre. The area is excellent for visitors both to see the town itself and for exploring the surrounding countryside, the wild Dartmoor scenery and the many neighbouring pretty villages and a variety of National Trust properties.
