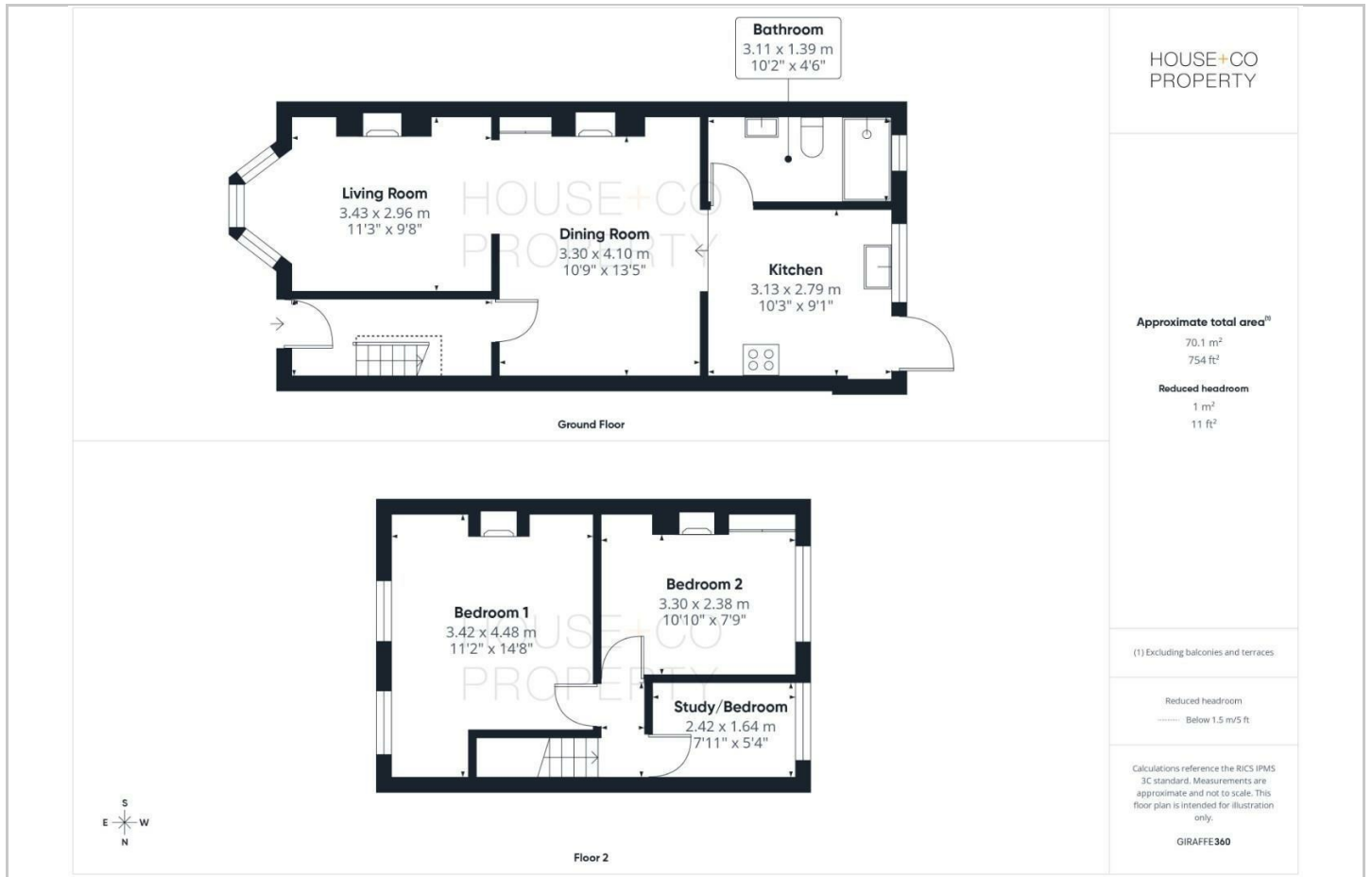

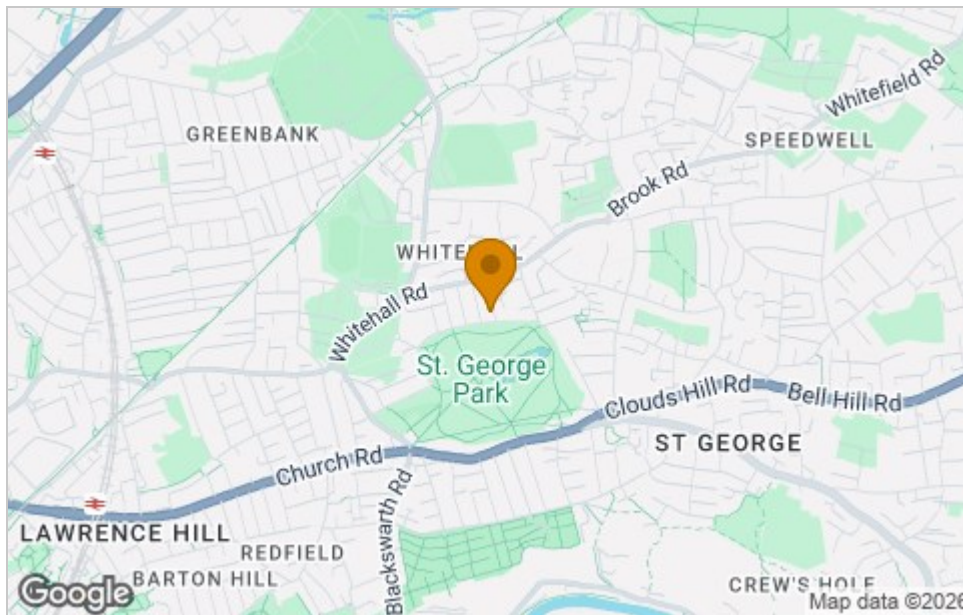




Floor Plan



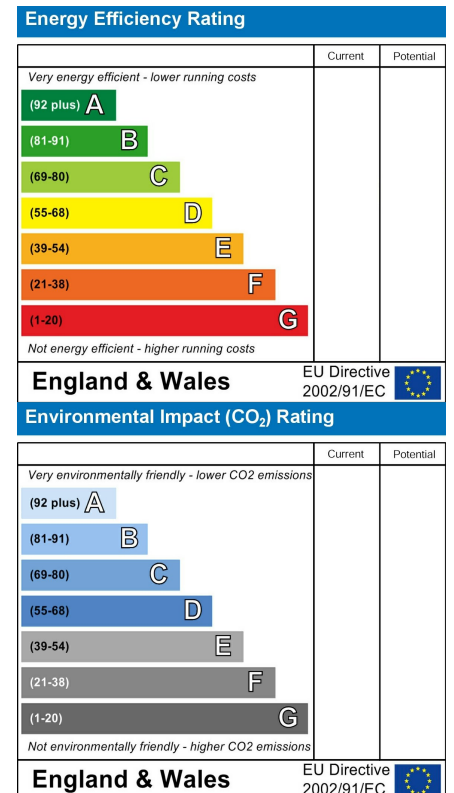
Area Map
