## ACCOMMODATION

### GROUND FLOOR

#### Hallway

Stairs to first floor, tiled flooring and smooth ceiling with sunken spotlights.

#### Lounge

3.70m x 3.66m (12'1" x 12'0")  
A well-presented and inviting reception room featuring a central wood-burning stove set within a recessed fireplace, creating a warm focal point. The space is enhanced by dual aspect windows allowing for excellent natural light, complemented by neutral décor and wood-effect flooring. Built-in shelving and storage provide both practicality and display space, while the room offers ample proportions for comfortable seating and everyday living.

#### Kitchen / Dining Room

4.66m x 2.73m (15'3" x 8'11")  
A bright and functional kitchen/dining space fitted with a range of modern wall and base units complemented by work surfaces and tiled splashbacks. The room features a range-style cooker, space for

additional appliances and ample storage, while the dining area comfortably accommodates a table for everyday meals. A rear-facing window and glazed door provide good natural light and offer direct access to the garden, making the space ideal for both family living and entertaining.

#### Bathroom

A modern ground floor bathroom fitted with a white three-piece suite comprising panelled bath with shower attachment, pedestal wash hand basin and low-level WC. The room is finished with contemporary tiled walls and flooring, complemented by a frosted window providing natural light and ventilation. A practical and well-appointed space suitable for everyday use.

Double glazed window to rear, heated towel rail, carpet to floor and smooth ceiling with loft access,

3.73m x 3.29m (12'2" x 10'9")  
A spacious double bedroom featuring a large front-facing window allowing for plenty of natural light. The room is presented in soft, neutral tones and benefits from fitted storage, along with ample space for additional bedroom furniture. A comfortable and well-proportioned principal bedroom ideal for everyday living.

#### Bedroom Two

4.67m x 2.76m (15'3" x 9'0")  
A well-proportioned double bedroom benefiting from a dual aspect, allowing for excellent natural light throughout the day. The room is tastefully decorated in soft tones and offers ample space for bedroom furniture. An airing cupboard provides useful additional storage, making the room both practical and versatile for use as a guest room, child's bedroom or home office.

### EXTERIOR

#### OFFICE / OUTBUILDING

6.78m x 3.19m (22'2" x 10'5")  
A versatile multi-purpose outbuilding offering excellent additional accommodation, ideal for use as a home office, studio, gym or guest space. The room is enhanced by a vaulted ceiling with exposed timber finish, creating a bright and airy feel, while multiple windows allow for an abundance of natural light. French doors provide direct access, further enhancing its usability and connection to the garden. A flexible and well-presented space suited to a variety of needs.

#### Driveway & Parking

The block paved driveway offers parking for 3 cars and a pathway leads you to the front door, and access to the rear garden.

#### Garden

A well-maintained and attractively landscaped rear garden featuring a generous lawn area complemented by a large paved patio, ideal for

outdoor dining and entertaining. The space is further enhanced by a dedicated barbecue area, creating a perfect setting for social gatherings. Enclosed by fencing for privacy, the garden also offers a variety of planted borders, making it both practical and enjoyable for everyday use.
