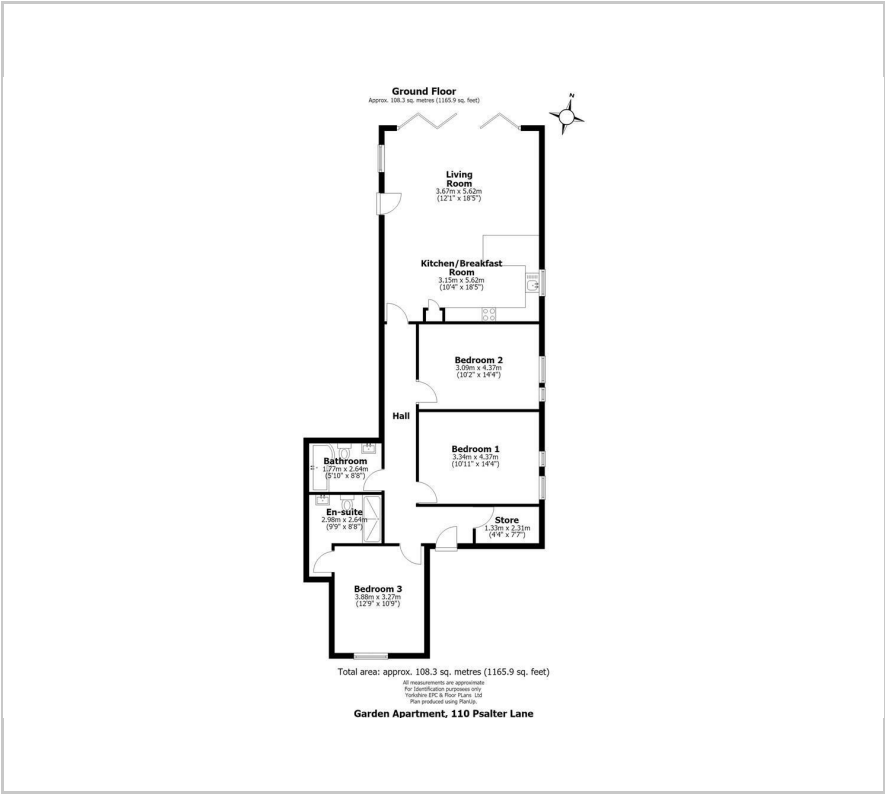

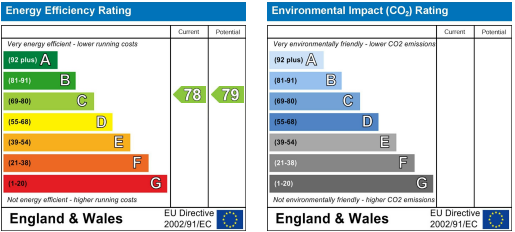
Floor Plan
