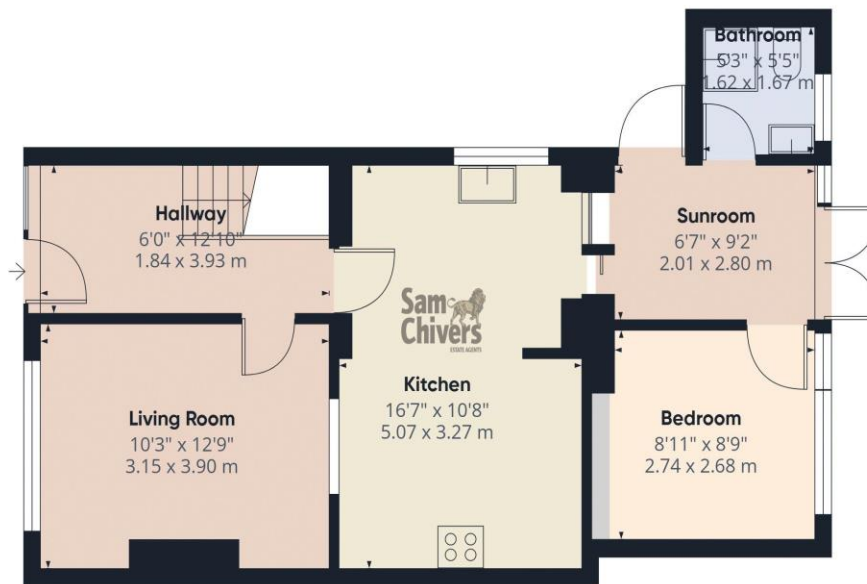

Outside to front is an expansive level lawn and private drive leading to the side of the property to a garage. Gated access into a large and level south facing garden with patio and lawn.

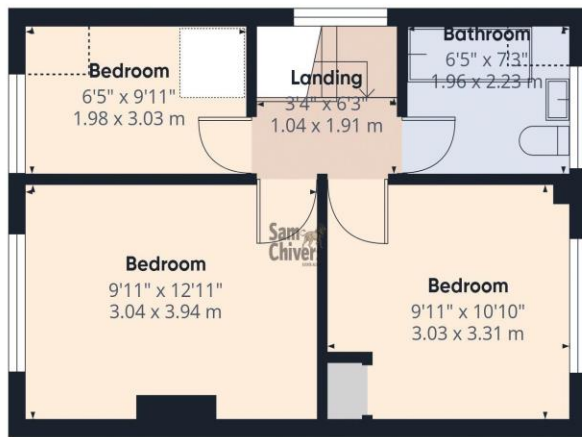

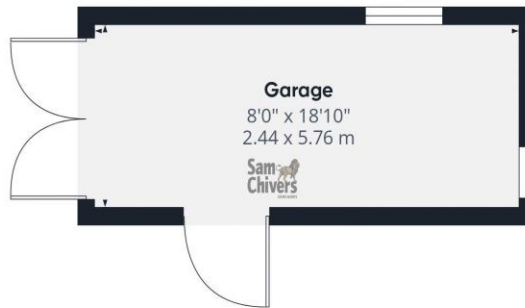




Floor 0 Building 1
