Description

Roundtree is a 4-bedroom semi-detached house with a double carport within the boutique development of Paddock Grove. Upon entering Roundtree, you are welcomed with a spacious and bright hallway with downstairs W/C. A bespoke shaker style Sigma Kitchen compliments the white quartz worktops and integrated Neff appliances. The large central island provides further storage with space for bar stools. The ground floor of Roundtree is designed in such a way that it is ideal for modern living, the open-plan kitchen/dining/family area is a great space for entertaining and provides access to the generously sized garden. Whilst there is a separate lounge, it is accessible from the kitchen and creates a further space for comfort and entertainment. Additionally, a well appointed utility room is situated just off the kitchen, providing dedicated space for white goods.

The principal bedroom includes a luxury ensuite with walk-in shower and bath finished with Porcelain tiles. A further 2 bedrooms are served by a family bathroom. On the second floor is the 2nd bedroom with ensuite shower room and dressing area. The front of the property features a double car port providing access to the rear garden. The generous rear garden is mainly laid to lawn, with a private terrace. *Some photographs are taken from other houses within Paddock Grove.

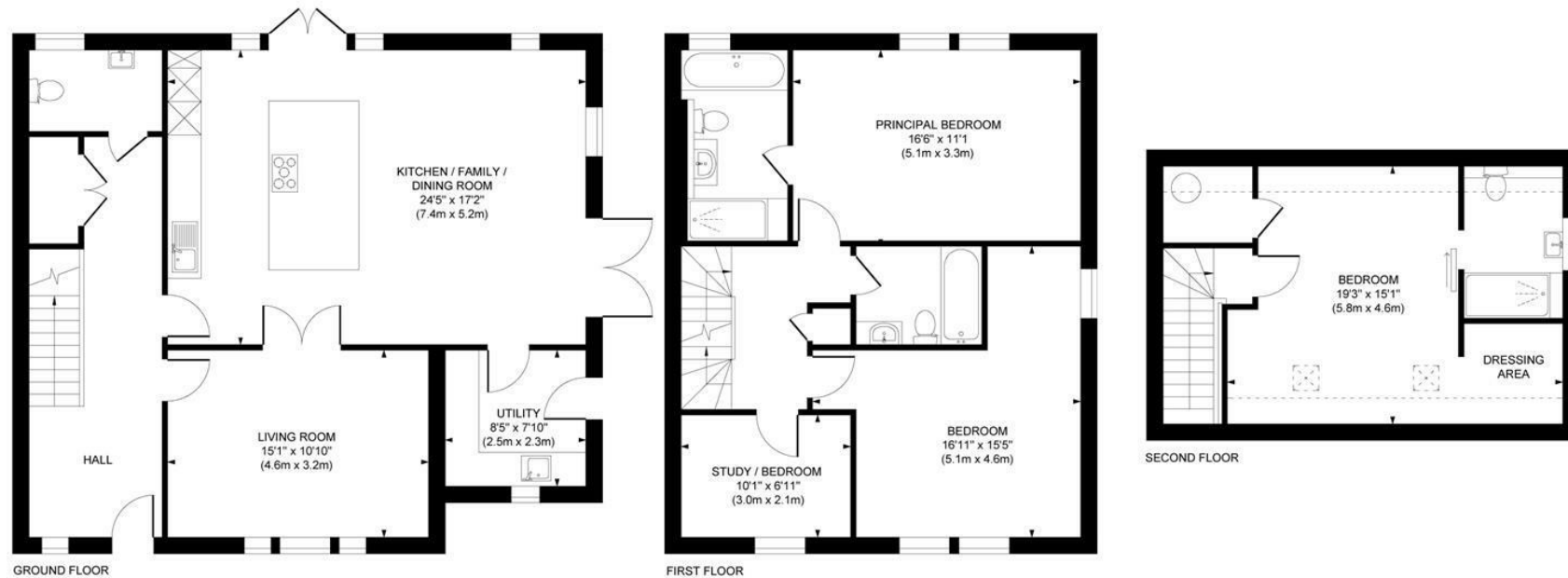
Situation
