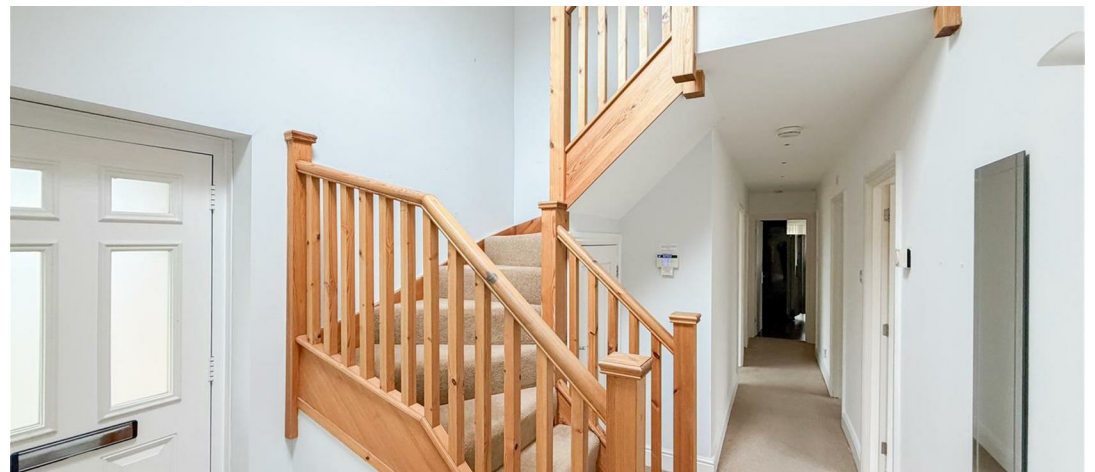

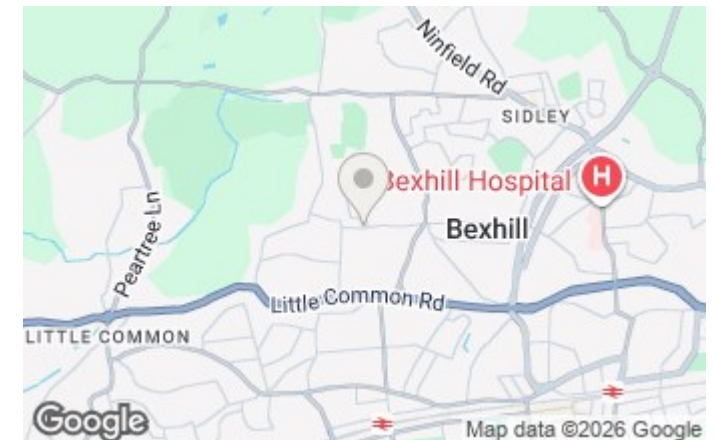

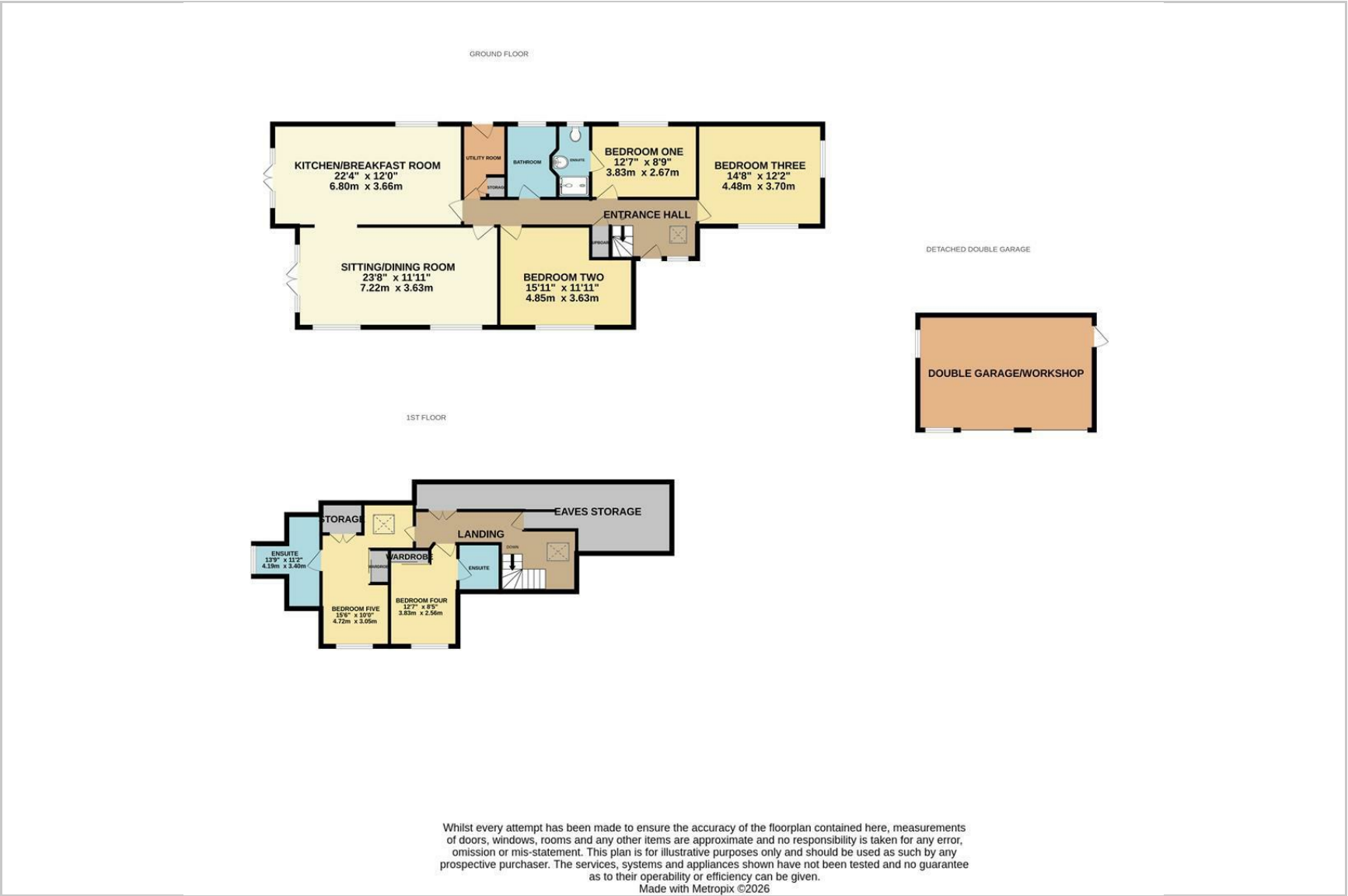

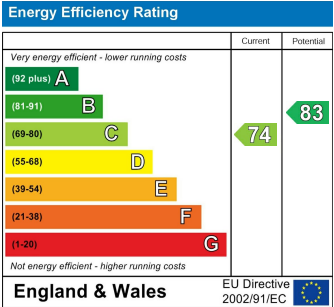
Area Map
